

Celebr8 Free Spirit Mini Album

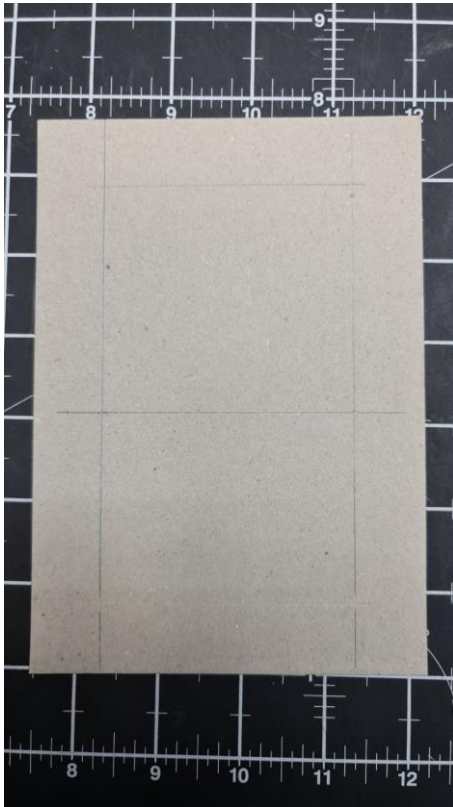
You will need:	
Celebr8 Free Spirit Mini Paper Pack	Double-sided tape (DST)
Celebr8 Mini Album kit	Coffee cardstock
Kraft (I used the kraft from the chippie)	Foam tape 3mm (optional)
Brilliance Crimson Copper	Acetate
Brad (just 1)	Eyelets (5)
Paper trimmer / craft knife	Small, sharp scissors for fussy cutting
Bone folder	Scoreboard
Bling (optional)	Beads for shaker box

Important Information, please read carefully before you start.

- All measurements are given in **centimetres**.
- Measurements are given **width x height**.
- Cut all your base pages first and keep all the bits for matting and making tags etc.
- **Please note which side of the pattern paper is used! Use the photos to assist you.**
- Fussy cut one of each side of the fussy cutting elements sheets as follows:
 - **PP5915 – borders**
 - **PP5916 – words**
 - **PP5917 – Journaling cards**
 - **PP5918 – Fussy cutting sheet**
 - **PP5919 – tags, banners and circles (remember, you can use circle punches to punch the circles).**
- Ensure that you use good quality double-sided tape.
- **DST = double-sided tape** **AS = Advertising strip (barcode)**
- **RHS = Right hand side** **LHS = Left hand side**
- **PP = Patterned Paper** **CS = Cardstock**

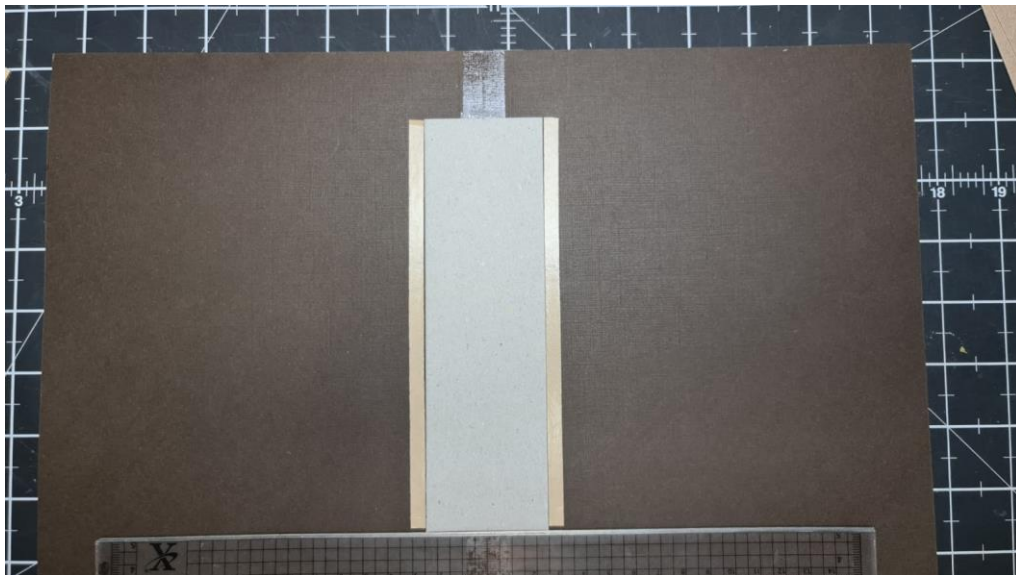
Album Cover

- From **coffee/dark brown cardstock**, cut 2 identical pieces measuring **18cm x 22cm**.
- Join these 2 pieces of cardstock together to create a single piece of cardstock measuring 36cm x 22cm.
- Adhere DST around the outside edge of the hardboard for the spine and one of the cover pieces as well as a few strips in the centre of the hardboard.
- Take the second piece of hardboard and cut out a rectangle, measuring 7,5cm x 7cm. I measured in 2cm from each side and 2cm from the top of the board down to obtain the first 3 lines and then measured 7cm from the top line to create the bottom of the rectangle.

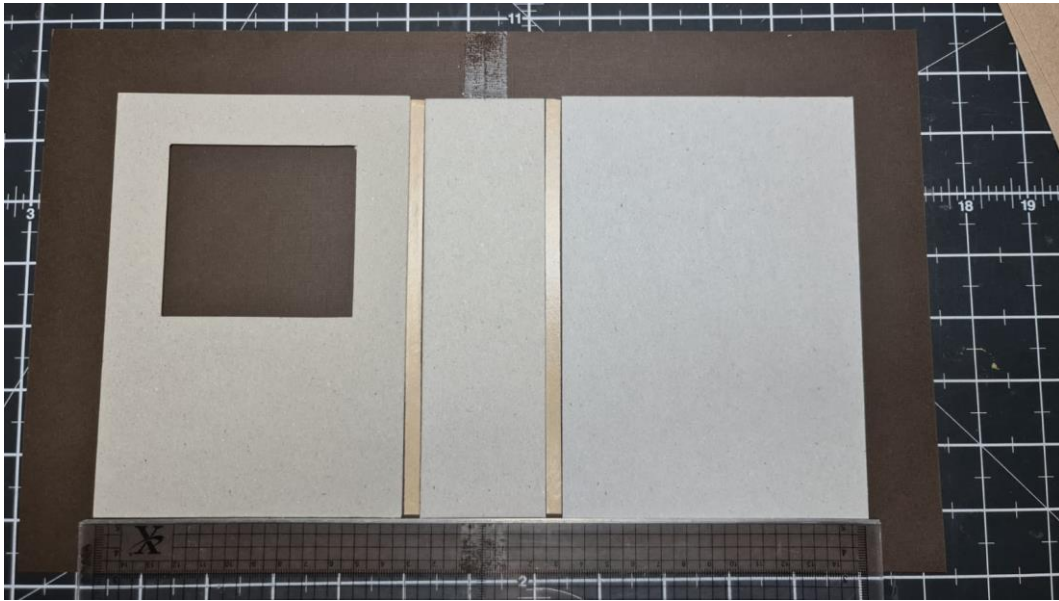


Cut the rectangle out carefully to create the “window”.

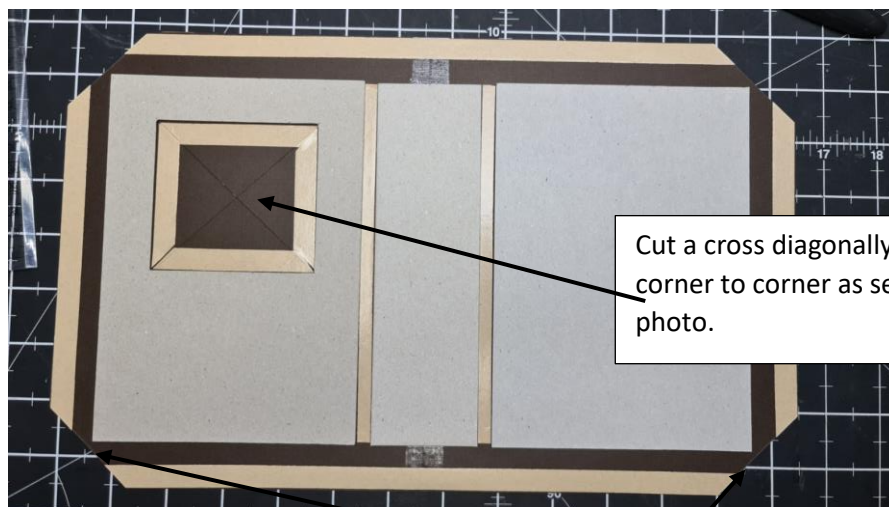
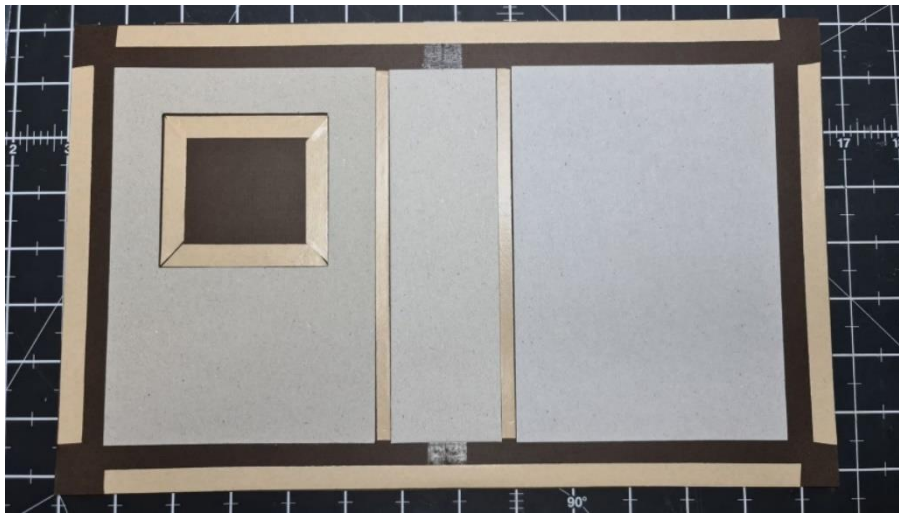
- Starting with the spine, remove the release tape and place it in the centre (top and bottom and left to right {approx. 2cm border all around}) of this newly created “outer cover”, then add a piece of 6mm tape on either side of the spine (you need this gap to stop the spine from tearing) before attaching the covers in line with the base of spine.



- Remove the release tape from the back of the front and back cover hardboard and add to the left and right of the spine.

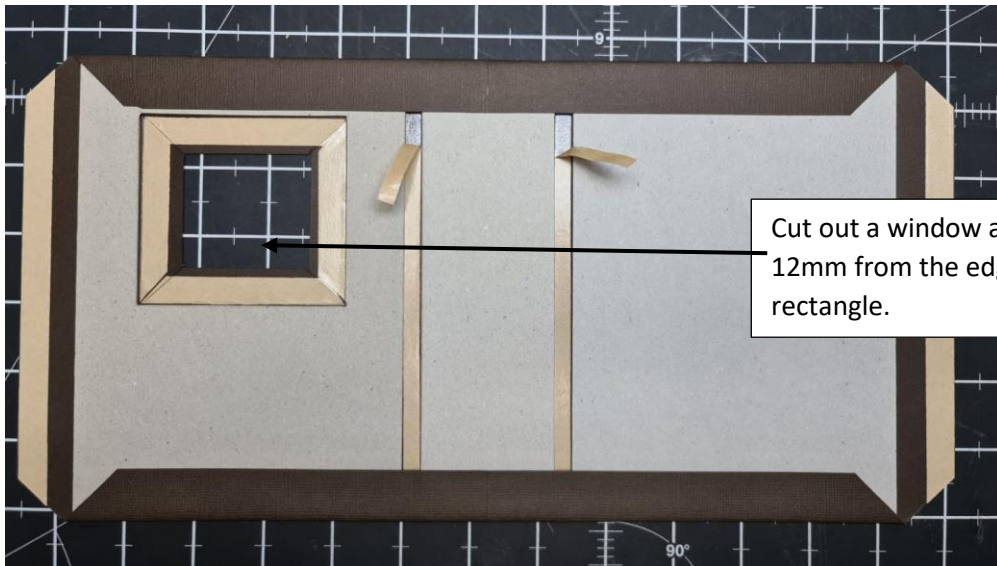


- Pop some DST all around the outer edge of the cardstock as well as some DST inside the small rectangle around the edge as seen below. Mitre corners.



Cut a cross diagonally from corner to corner as seen in the photo.

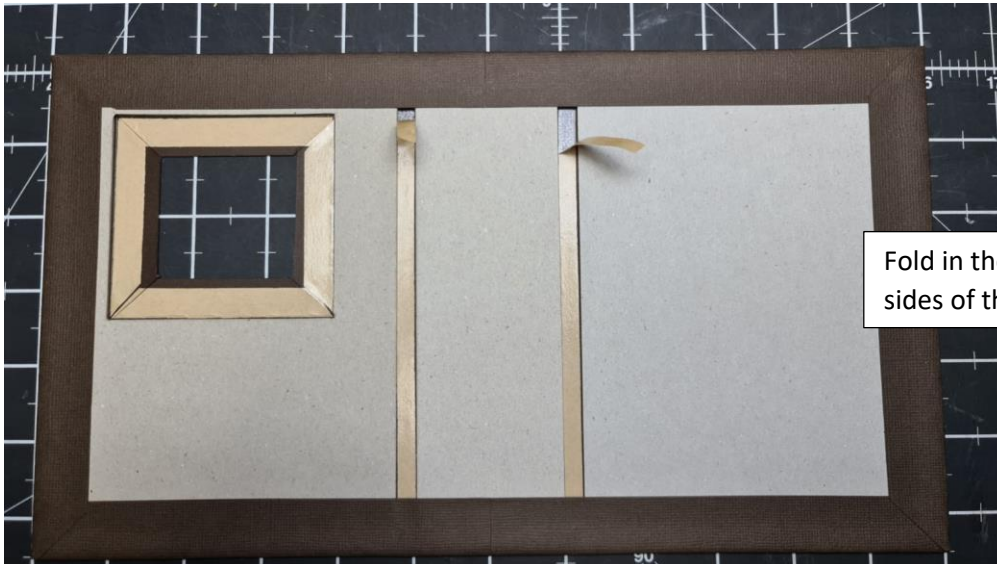
Mitre the corners to create neat corners.



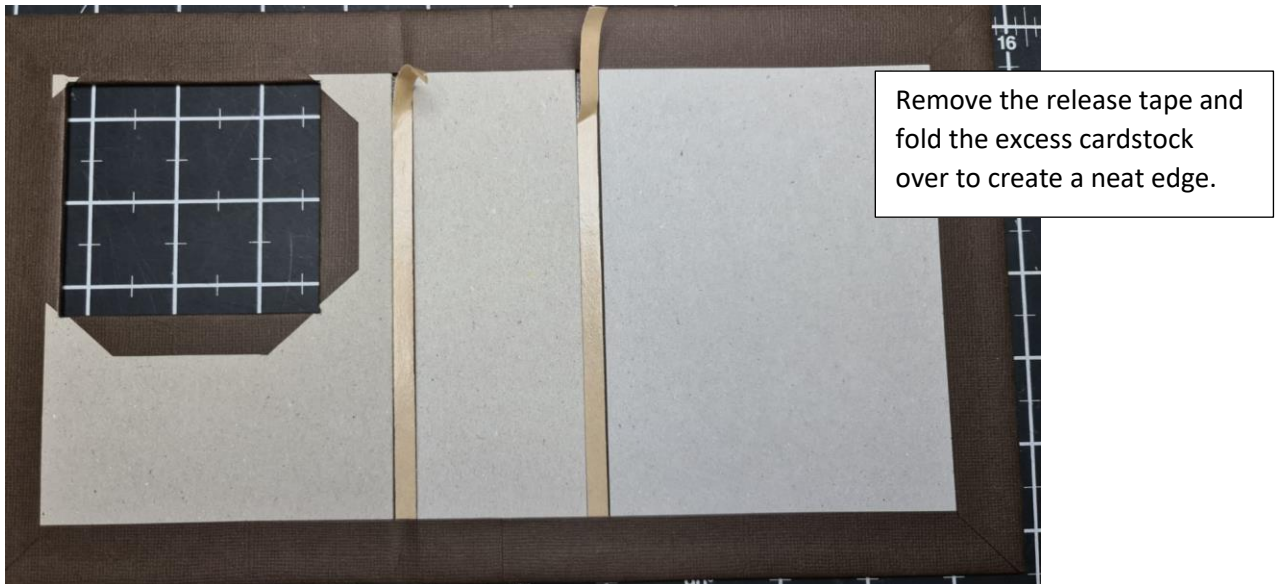
Cut out a window approximately 12mm from the edge of the rectangle.



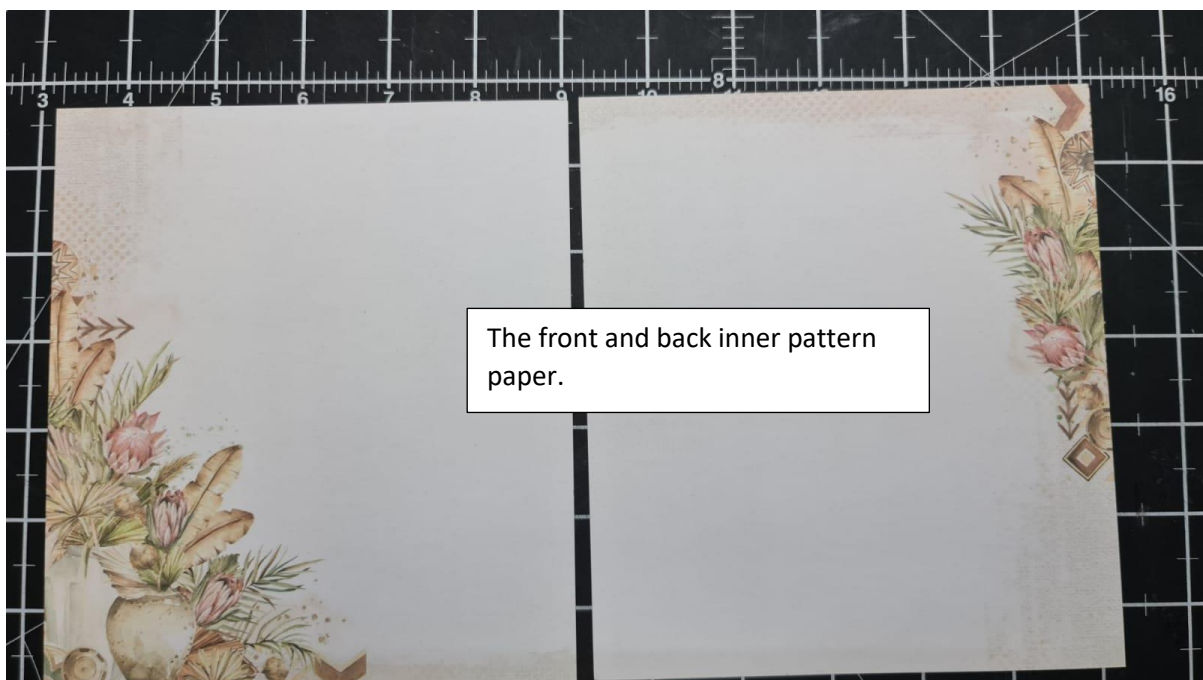
Fold in the cardstock on the "long sides" first. Tuck in the excess paper as shown.



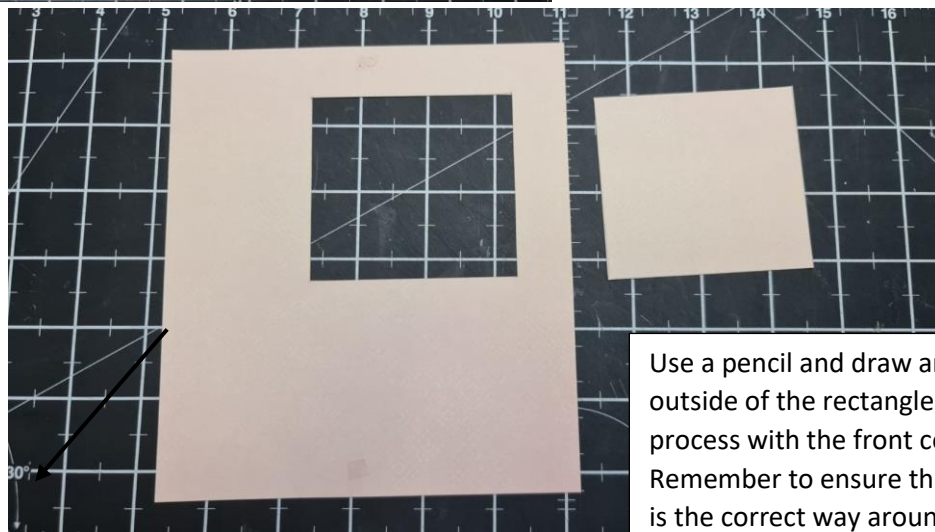
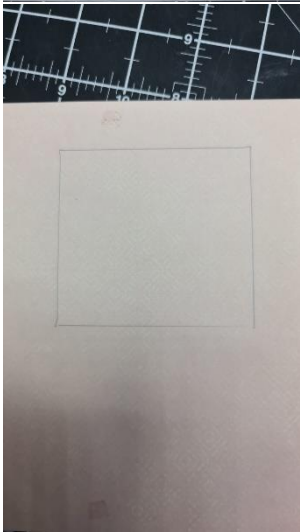
Fold in the paper on the short sides of the album.



- From PP5908 and PP5914, cut two pieces that measure 15cm x 16,7cm for the front outer cover and front inside cover. Make sure that you cut the paper so that you have the little images in your cut piece.

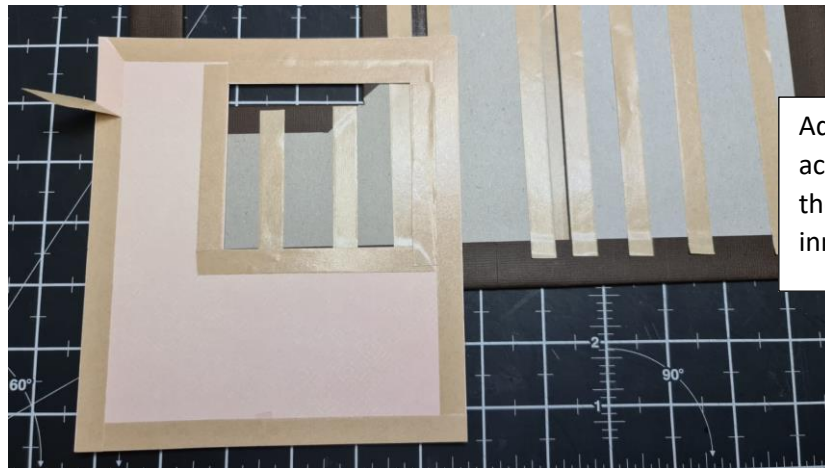


- Use the window as a template to cut the hole in both the front cover pattern paper PP5914 and the inside cover PP5908

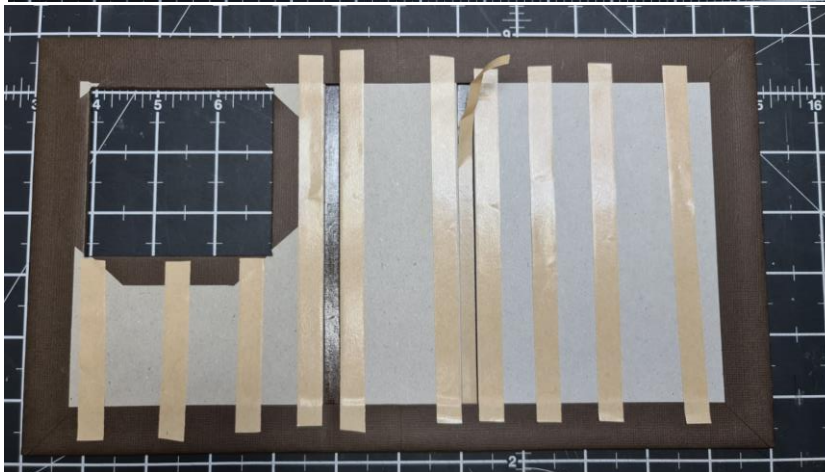


Use a pencil and draw around the outside of the rectangle. Repeat the process with the front cover. Remember to ensure that the paper is the correct way around. Cut out the rectangles.

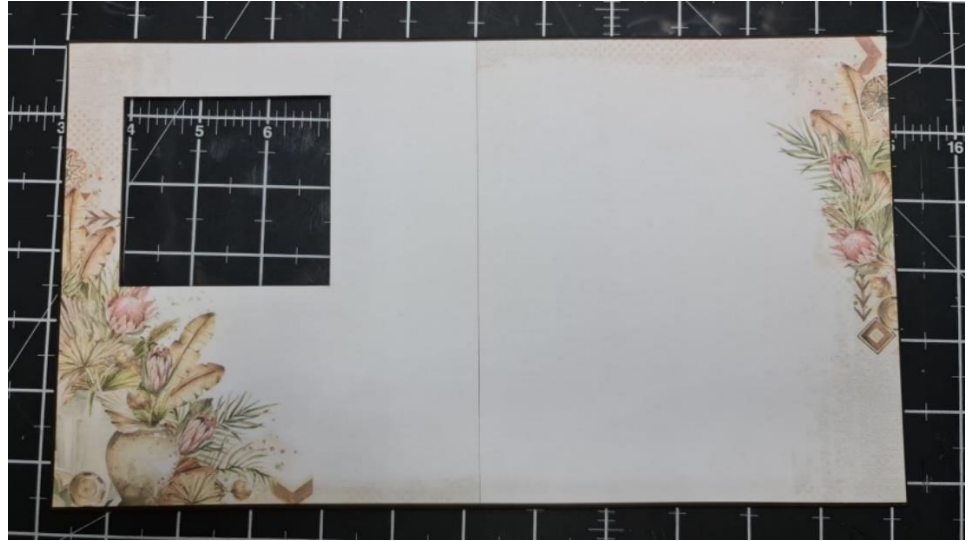
- Stick DST around the outer edges on the wrong/plain side making sure that you also add tape around the window. Add DST to the base of the album as shown in the second photo.
- To stop your inside covers from bulging, you will need to do the following:
 - Add a strip of 12mm tape on each side of the 6mm DST on the hard board (4 pieces in total running from top to bottom of the spine).
 - Add another strip of tape to the spine.
 - Add 2 strips of tape to the inside covers to assist with anchoring the pattern paper.
- Carefully remove the DST from the hardboard, including the DST from the 6mm gap between the hardboard and the pattern paper, and attach the inside covers to both front and back.



Adhere 1 piece of acetate to the cover and then stick down the inner cover mat.



- From PP5909, cut a piece that measures 15cm x 16,7cm for the back inside cover and stick DST around the outer edges on the wrong/plain side. Make sure that you cut the paper so that you have the little image in your cut piece.



- Adhere the pattern paper to the front of the album.
- Cut a piece of ribbon measuring 13cm in length. Cut each end into a "v" shape. Adhere to the leftover piece of pattern paper from the front outer cover measuring approximately 3,2cm x 16,8cm.
- Fold the ribbon in half and adhere to the strip for the spine using a brad prior to sticking the strip down.



- Make up the base pages as per the instructions and adhere to the mini album.

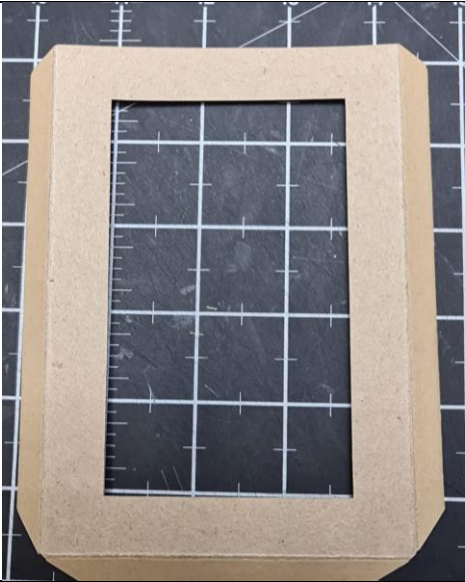


Your base pages should look like this when made up. Once complete, add to inside of album.

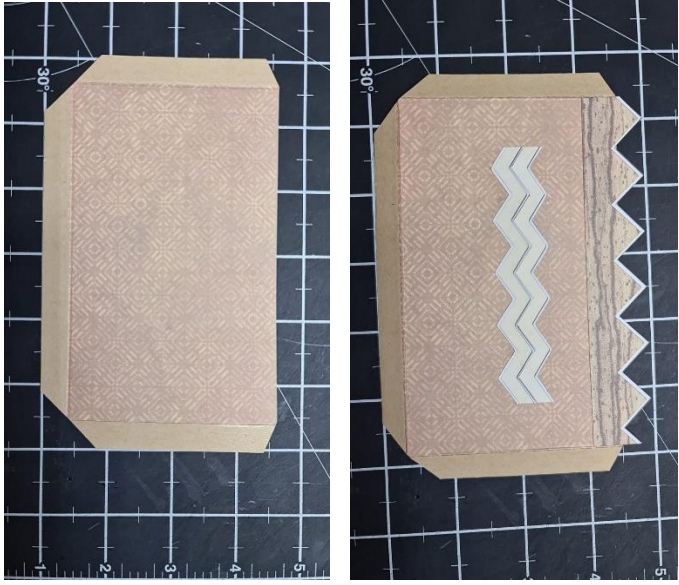

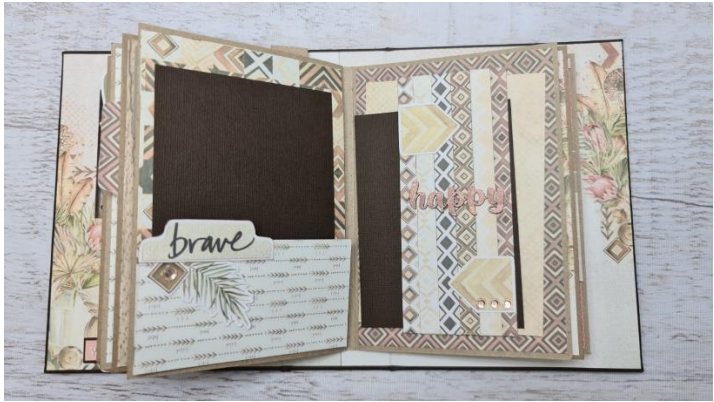

1	PP5911	1	10cm x 14,5cm	Chalk edge with Brilliance Crimson Copper and adhere to bottom of page. Add embellishment. 
		1	9cm x 5cm	
2	PP5913	1	21cm x 14,5cm	DO NOT REMOVE THE ADVERTISING STRIP! With the AS up against the LHS of the scoreboard, score at 1cm and 11cm on the 21cm side. Apply DST to the 1cm area created by the score line (over the AS wording) to create a flap.
	PP5913	1	9cm x 14,5cm	

				 DO NOT REMOVE ADVERTISING STRIP.... Trim the page so that the chevron AS line up. 
3	Kraft	1	12cm x 15,5cm	Cut this piece using the back of the kraft paper supplied with the chippie. Score at 1cm and 11cm on the 12cm side. Turn 90° and score at 14,5cm on the 15,5cm side. From the score lines (on 3 sides), measure in 1,5cm as well as 1,5cm from the top of the pocket and remove the rectangle to make space for the acetate window. Adhere the acetate using DST to the reverse of the pocket. Add DST to the right side in the 1cm areas created by the score lines. Mitre corners and fold in sides, ready to attach to page.

	PP5916		Words	Choose some of the words from the top half of the sheet to use as a border. Chalk with Brilliance Crimson Copper.
	PP5916	1	8cm x 14cm	Use the dotted side and adhere to base page prior to adding the pocket.
	White CS	1	9cm x 14cm	Adhere "brave" tab to the top of the page.
4	PP5914	1	15cm x 14,5cm	Score at 5cm on the 15cm side. Adhere to page with just a few strips of DST to create an open tuck spot.
				
	PP5909	1	6,5cm x 14,5cm	Use the off cut from page 13 PP5909.
	White CS	1	15cm x 11,5cm	Score at 7,5cm on the 15cm side. Fold.

5	PP5917	1	10cm x 14,5cm	Include the AS in your cutting. Fussy cut the image from PP5918 and adhere just the bottom part of the image to the page to allow for a tuck spot. (see photos of page 5 with page 4 images)
	PP5917	1	15cm x 10cm	Cut journaling card in half to create 2 mini photo mats. Score at 7,5cm on the 15cm side and fold. Retain other half of journaling cards for page 7.
6	PP5910	1	10cm x 14,5cm	Stick acetate before sticking this piece of PP to the page. 
	Acetate	1	9,5cm x 15cm	Score at 1cm on the 15cm side. Apply DST to the 1cm area created by the score line. Fold over and adhere to page. Add the PP to "hide" the acetate attachment.
7	PP5917	1	9cm x 15cm	Score at 1cm and 14cm on the 15cm side. Turn 90° and score at 1cm on the 9cm side. Add DST to the right side in the 1cm areas created by the score lines. Mitre corners and fold in sides, ready to attach to page. Fussy cut a border strip from PP5915 (I used the chevron) and cut down to 9,5cm. Adhere to pocket using strong glue. Using your craft knife, carefully cut along the zigzag line to create a pocket. Attach pocket to base page. Add extra border along edge to create interest.

				
8	PP5912	1	21cm x 14,5cm	DO NOT REMOVE THE ADVERTISING STRIP! With the AS up against the LHS of the scoreboard, score at 1cm and 11cm on the 21cm side. Apply DST to the 1cm area created by the score line (over the AS wording) to create a flap. (You will do exactly the same for page 8 and 9)  

				
9	PP5912	1	21cm x 14,5cm	DO NOT REMOVE THE ADVERTISING STRIP! With the AS up against the LHS of the scoreboard, score at 1cm and 11cm on the 21cm side. Apply DST to the 1cm area created by the score line (over the AS wording) to create a flap.
10	PP5910	1	10cm x 21cm	DO NOT REMOVE THE ADVERTISING STRIP! With the AS up against the LHS of the scoreboard, score at 1cm and 15,5cm on the 21cm side. Apply DST to the 1cm area created by the score line (over the AS wording) to create a flap. Adhere flap to top of base page.  
11	PP5919	1	10cm x 14,5cm	Adhere to page.
	Brown CS	1	5,5cm x 15cm	Select 6 of the AS that you have cut from the PP. Adhere to the piece of brown cardstock to create the belly band strip.

				Score at 1cm and 14cm on the 15cm side. Apply DST to the right side in the 1cm area created by the score line. Mitre corners and adhere to base page. See images for page 11 with page 10 instructions.
12	PP5908	1	10cm x 14,5cm	Ensure that you include the desired images when cutting both page 12 and 13.
13	PP5909	1	10cm x 14,5cm	
14	PP5915 PP5910	1 1	10cm x 14,5cm 12cm x 5,5cm	Score at 1cm and 11cm on the 12cm side. Turn 90° and score at 4,5cm on the 5,5cm side. Add DST to the right side in the 1cm areas created by the score lines. Mitre corners Add border strip to top of the pocket.  
15	PP5916	1	20cm x 14,5cm	Score at 10cm on the 20cm side. Remove some of the words to create interest in the flap. See photos in 14!

16	PP5911	1	20cm x 14,5cm	Score at 5cm and 15cm on the 20cm side. Adhere centre panel to the base album.
