You will need:	
Celebr8 Mini Album Kit	12mm Double-sided tape (DST)
2 x White Cardstock	A4 Acetate
Versa Magic Beige	Versa Magic Gingerbread
Scoreboard	Bone folder
Paper trimmer / craft knife	Small, sharp scissors for fussy cutting
Glue	

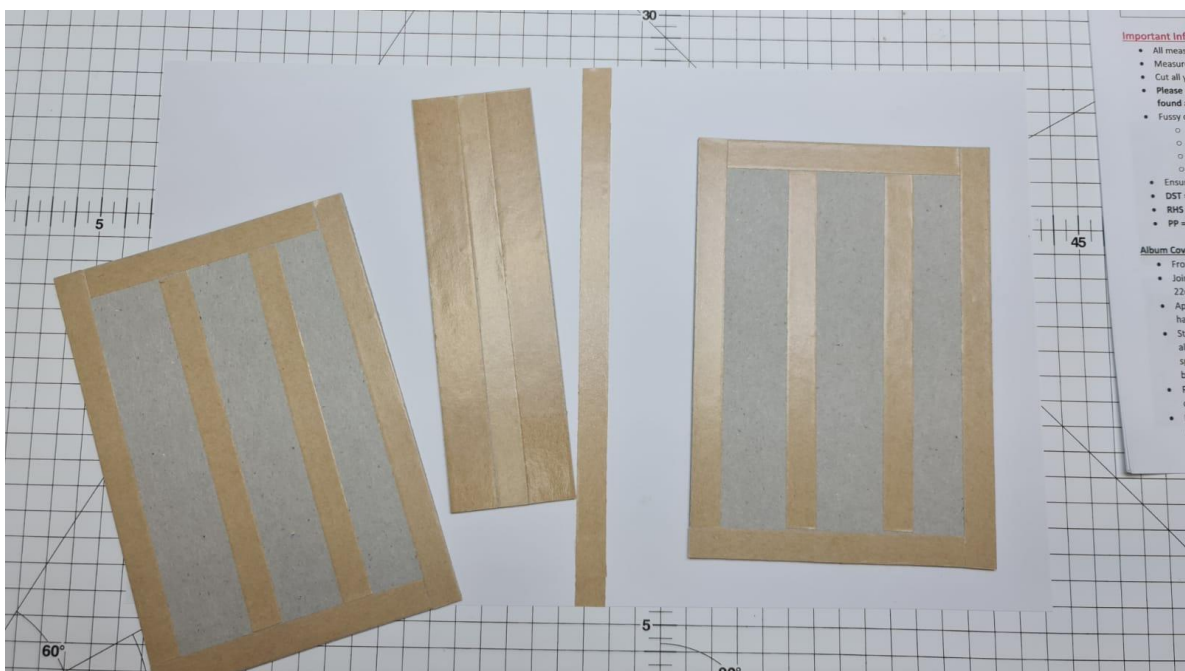
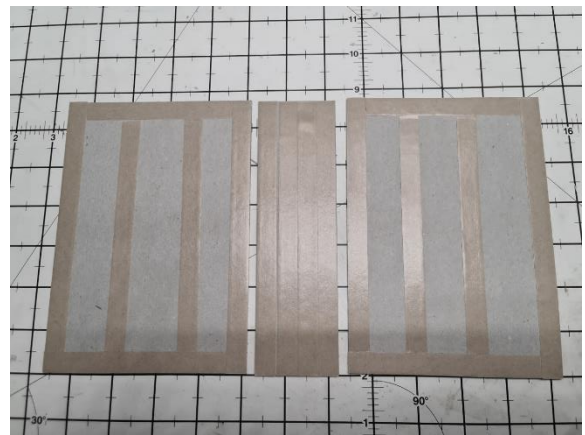
Important Information, please read carefully before you start.

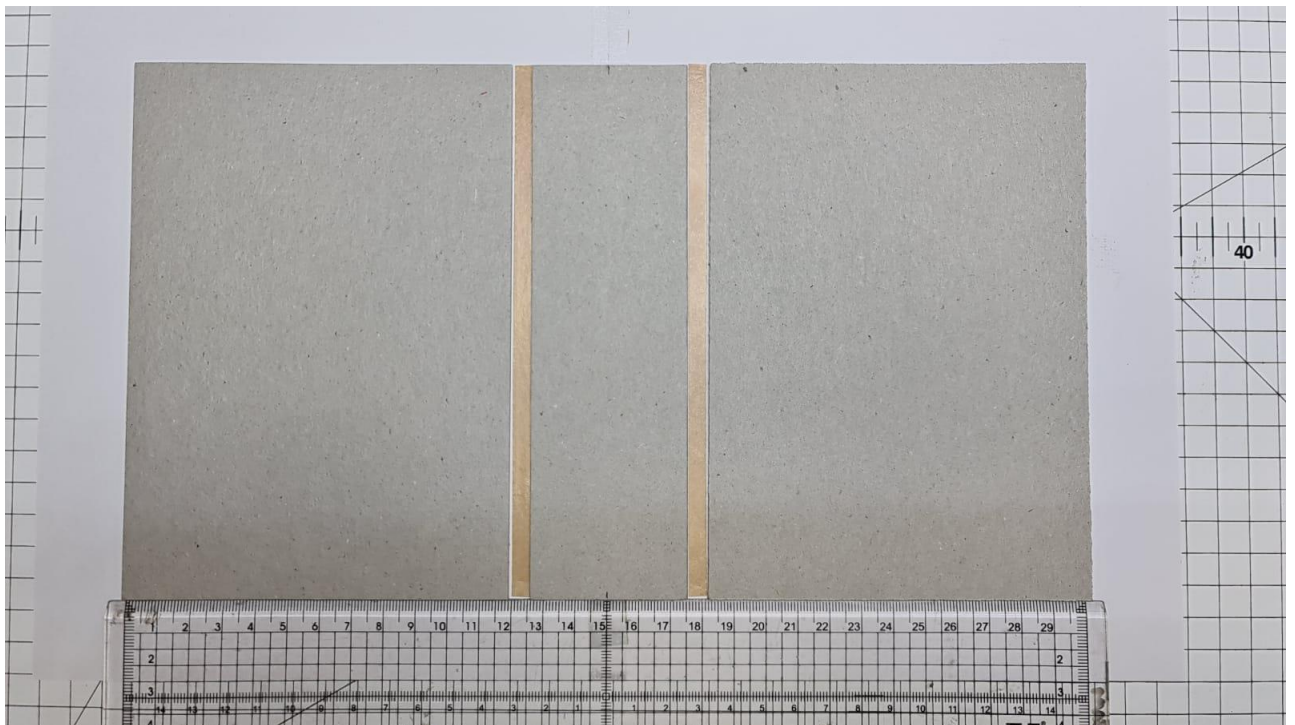
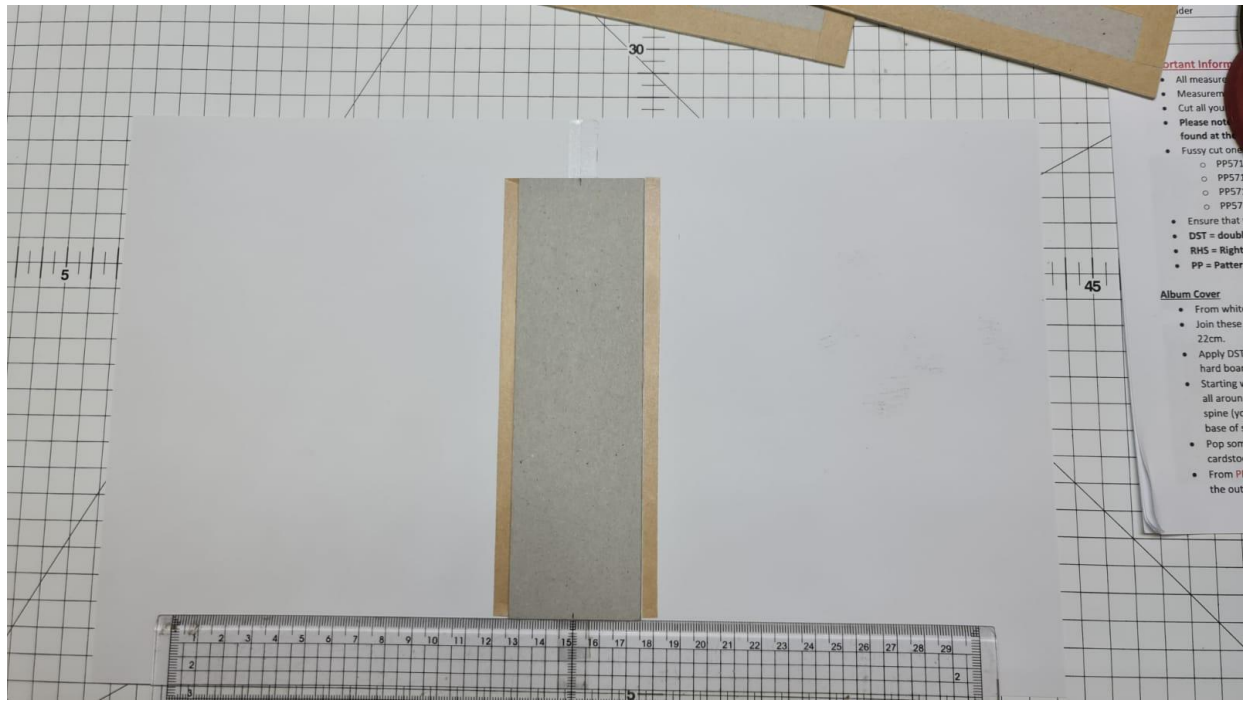
- All measurements are given in **centimetres**.
- Measurements are given **width x height**.
- Cut all your base pages first and keep all the bits for matting and making tags etc.
- **Please note which side of the pattern paper is used!**
- Fussy cut one of each side of the fussy cutting elements sheets as follows:
 - PP6414 – Cut one set of journaling cards apart to create 4 individual cards.
 - PP6415 – I didn't use this sheet but it would be a great idea to keep it close for adding "words" next to photos.
 - PP6416 – fussy cut tags, circles and tabs.
 - PP6417 – cut for use on page 7 to 10. Each square is 5cm.
 - PP6418 – fussy cut all the elements. Use for decorating throughout the mini.
 - PP6419 – Use a 1½" punch to punch out the circles.
- Ensure that you use good quality double-sided tape.
- **DST = double-sided tape** **AS = Advertising strip (barcode)**
- **RHS = Right hand side** **LHS = Left hand side**
- **PP = Patterned Paper**

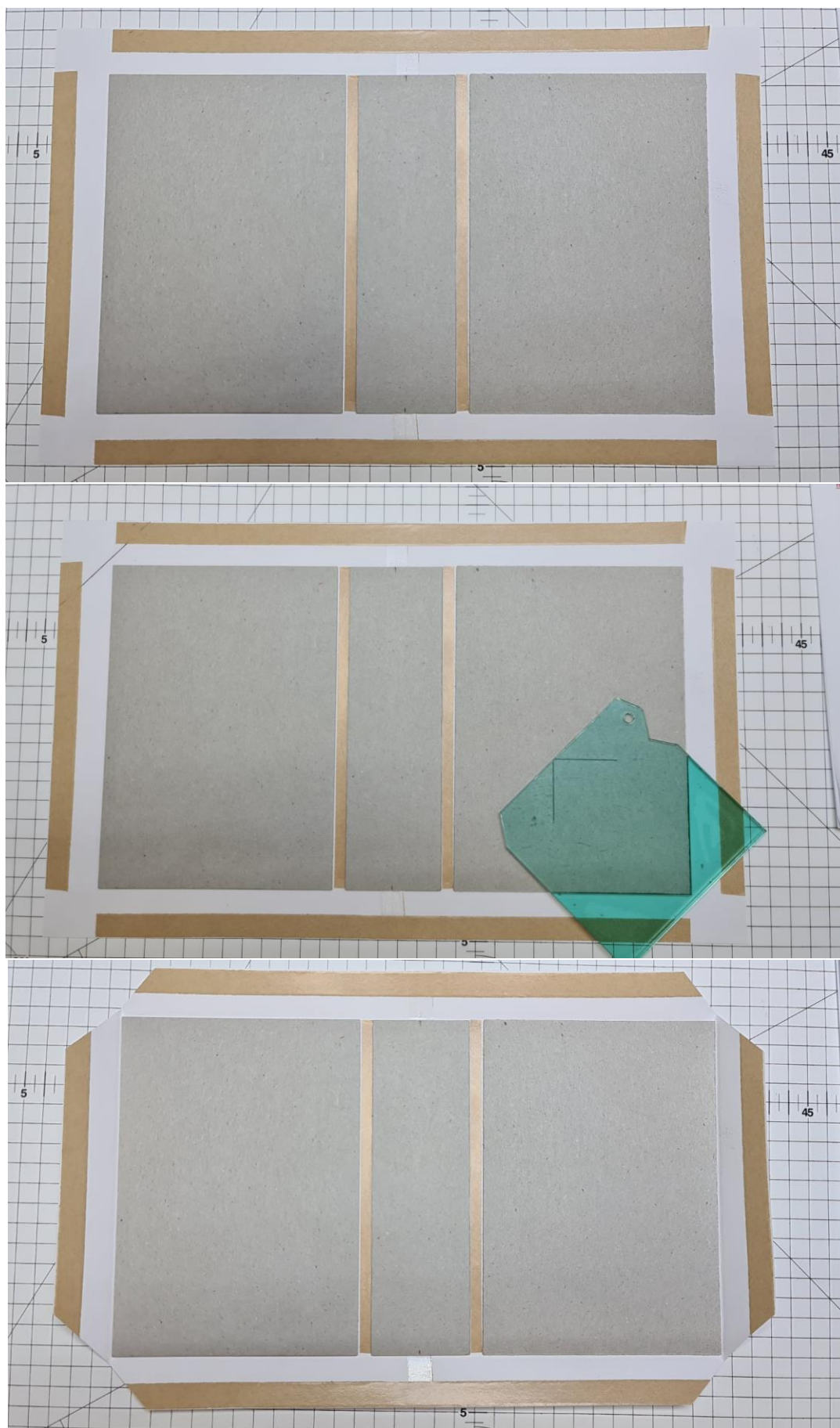
Album Cover (use photos below to assist)

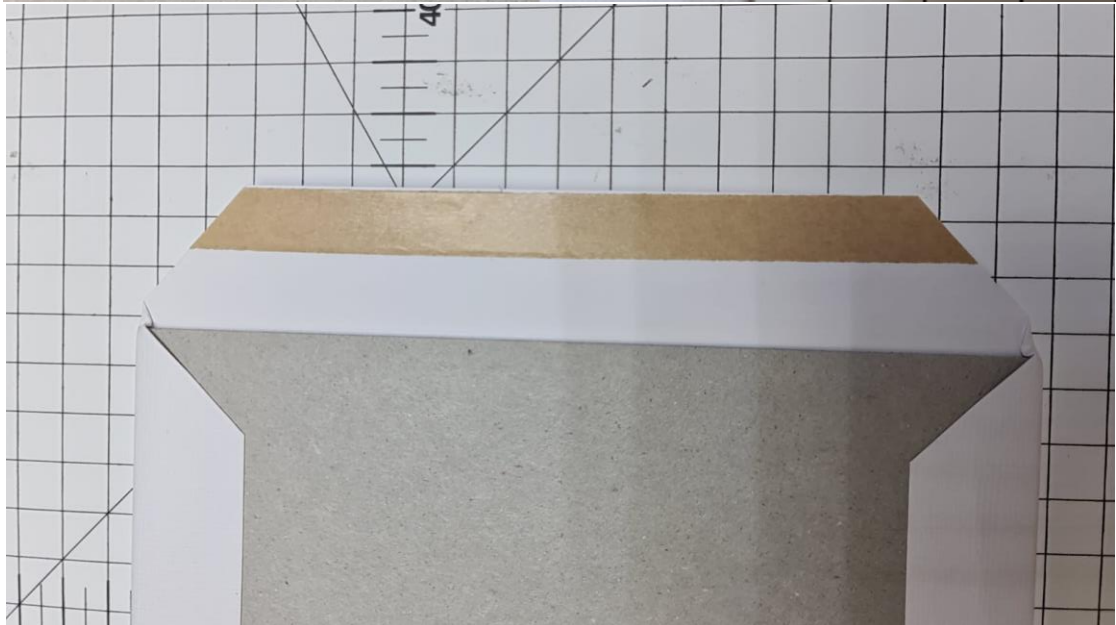
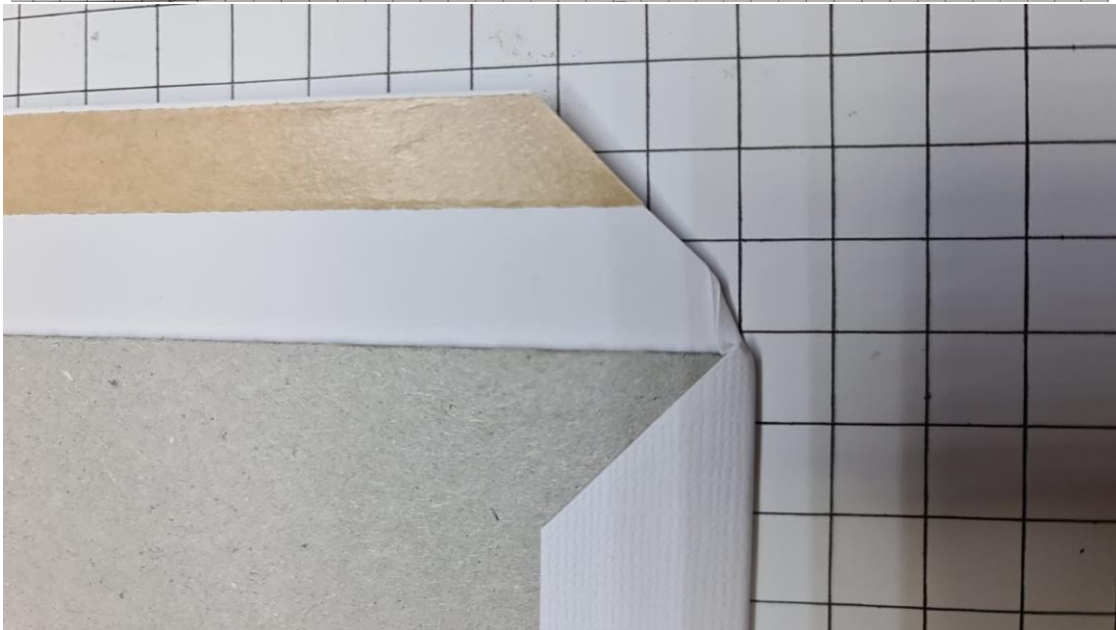
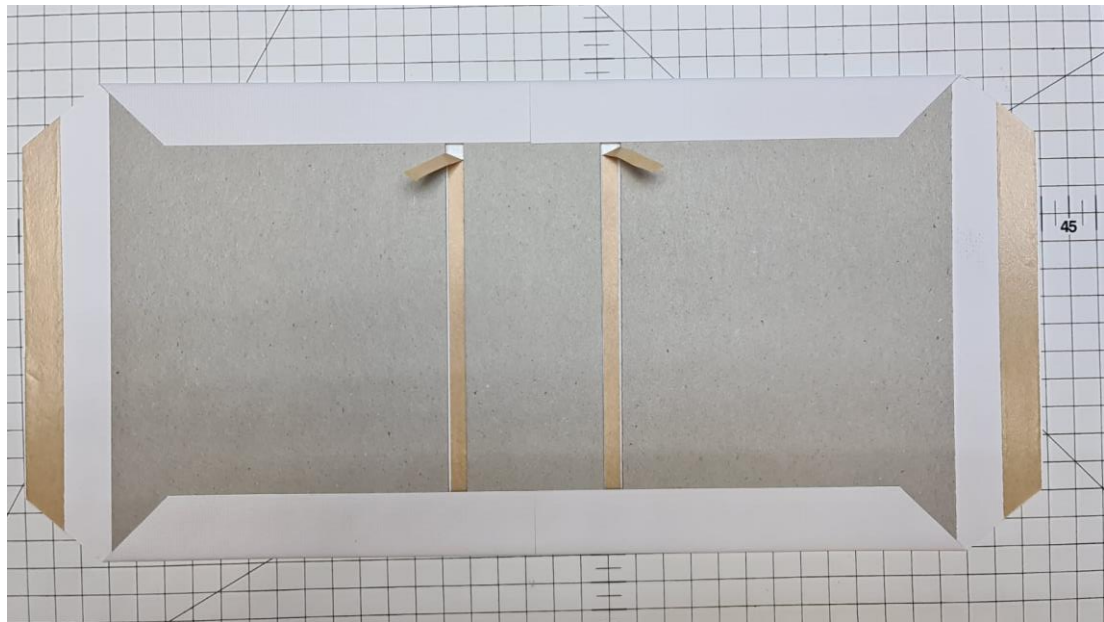
- From white cardstock, cut 2 identical pieces measuring **18cm x 22cm**.
- Join these 2 pieces of cardstock together to create a single piece of cardstock measuring 36cm x 22cm.
- Adhere DST around the outside edge of the hardboard as well as a few strips in the centre of the hardboard.
- Starting with the spine, place it in the centre (top and bottom and left to right {approx. 2cm border all around}) of this newly created "outer cover", then add a piece of 6mm tape on either side of the spine (you need this gap to stop the spine from tearing) before attaching the covers in line with the base of spine.
- Pop some DST all around the outer edge of the cardstock. Mitre corners, remove DST and fold cardstock in to complete the outer cover.

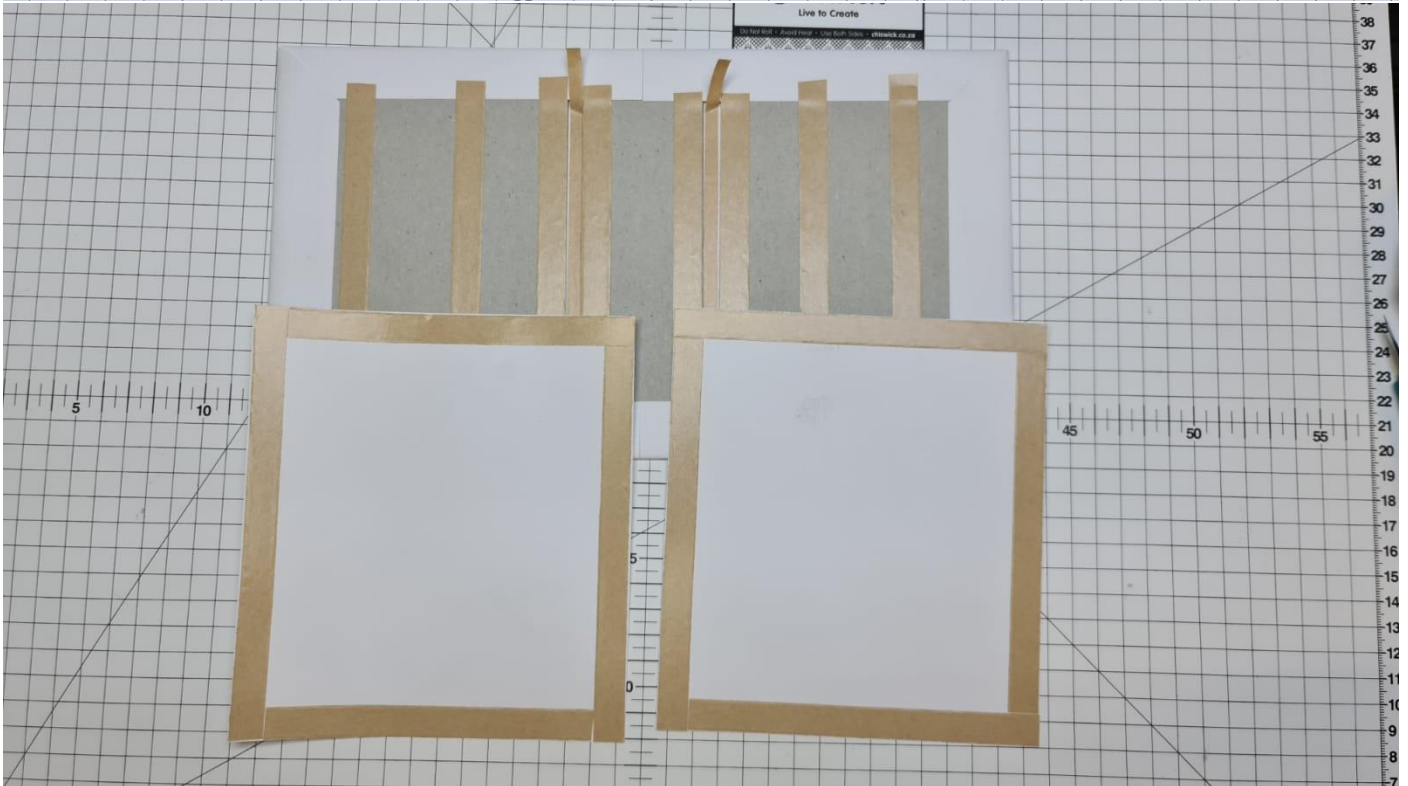
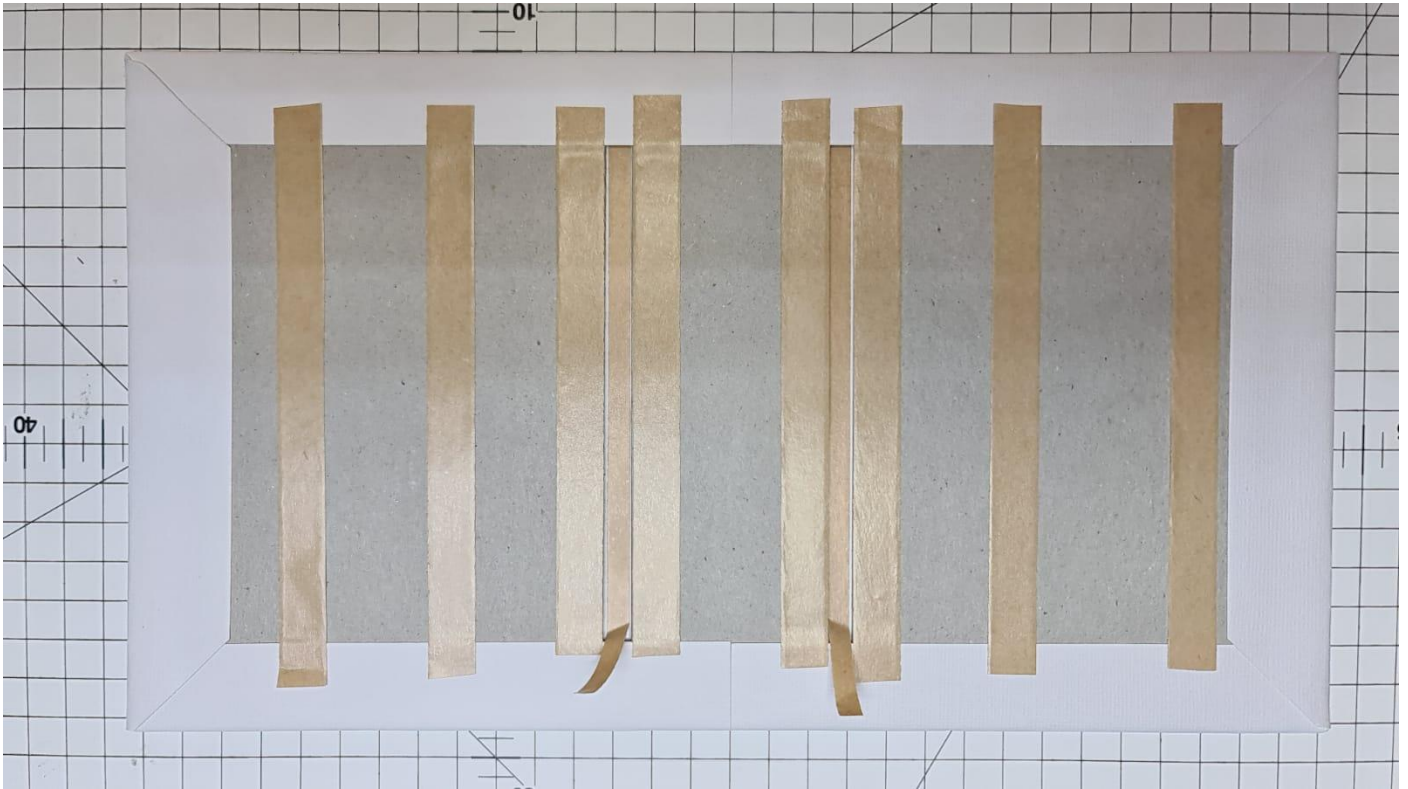
- From PP6410, cut a piece that measures 15cm x 16,7cm for the front inside cover. Stick DST around the outer edges on the wrong/plain side. Make sure that you cut the paper so that you have the image in your cut pieces.
- From PP6411, cut a piece that measures 15cm x 16,7cm for the back inside cover. Stick DST around the outer edges on the wrong/plain side.
- To stop your inside covers from bulging, you will need to do the following:
 - Add a strip of 12mm tape on each side of the 6mm DST on the hard board (4 pieces in total running from top to bottom of the spine).
 - Add another strip of tape to the spine.
 - Add 2 strips of tape to the inside covers to assist with anchoring the pattern paper.
- Carefully remove the DST from the hardboard, including the DST from the 6mm gap between the hardboard and the pattern paper, and attach the inside covers to both front and back.
- Make up the base pages as per the instructions and adhere to the mini album.

Decorating the Front Cover and spine

- From PP6412, cut a piece of patterned paper measuring 11,7cm x 16,7cm. Chalk the edge using Gingerbread Versa Magic.
- Use the fussy cutting elements from PP6418 to create the front cover.
- I used a silver pen to colour in the word “adorable”. The wording at the bottom of the front page is from one of the advertising strips.
- From the leftover strip from the front cover, cut a piece measuring 5cm x 16,7cm. Chalk using Gingerbread Versa Magic.
- Use the various circle elements from PP6416 to add interest.

2	PP6414	1	10cm x 14,5cm	Retain off cut for page 15. 
3	PP6413	1	20cm x 14,5cm	Score at 10cm on the 20cm side. 
4	PP6416	1	9,5cm x 13,5cm	Cut to create a frame 1,5cm thick. 
	Acetate	1	9cm x 13cm	Attach to reverse of frame using either glue or DST.
	White cardstock	1	7cm x 12,5cm	Attach to album using foam tape. Ensure that the gap between the "window" is at least 7cm. Tag.

				
5	PP6412	1	10cm x 20cm	Score at 14,5cm on the 20cm side. Adhere DST as seen in the photo below. Fold up to create a simple pocket. 
6	PP6409	1	10cm x 14,5cm	Fussy cut around the little bear image to create a tuck spot. 
7	PP6417 White cardstock	1	10cm x 14,5cm	Use 1,2 and 3 to create “patchwork” collage. Stitch around white squares using fine brown pen.

				
8	PP6417 White cardstock	1	10cm x 14,5cm	Use 4,5 and 6 create “patchwork” collage. Stitch around white squares using fine brown pen. 
9	PP6417 White cardstock	1	10cm x 14,5cm	Use 7,8 and 9 create “patchwork” collage. Stitch around white squares using fine brown pen.
10	PP6417 White cardstock	1	10cm x 14,5cm	Use 10,11 and 12 create “patchwork” collage. Stitch around white squares using fine brown pen. 
11	PP6409	1	10cm x 20cm	Score at 14,5cm on the 20cm side. Fold over to form flap.

				
12	PP6411	1	10cm x 20cm	Score at 14,5cm on the 20cm side. Adhere DST as seen in the photo below. Fold up to create a simple pocket.  
13	PP6416	1	9,5cm x 13,5cm	Cut to create a frame 1,5cm thick.

	Acetate	1	9cm x 13cm	 Attach to reverse of frame using either glue or DST. Attach to album using foam tape. Ensure that the gap between the “window” is at least 7cm.
	White cardstock	1	7cm x 12,5cm	
14	PP6413	1	20cm x 14,5cm	Score at 10cm on the 20cm side. 
15	PP6414	1	10cm x 14,5cm	Use off cut from page 2. 
16	PP6408	1	15cm x 14,5cm	Score at 10cm on 15cm side. Apply DST as seen below.
