You will need:	
Celebr8 Captured in Time Mini Paper Pack	6mm & 12mm Double-sided tape (DST)
2 x Pomegranate Cardstock	1 x Black Cardstock
1 x Cream Cardstock	Foam tape 3mm
Brilliance Crimson Copper	Acetate
Versa Magic Jumbo Java	Scoreboard
Paper trimmer / craft knife	Small, sharp scissors for fussy cutting
Bone folder	

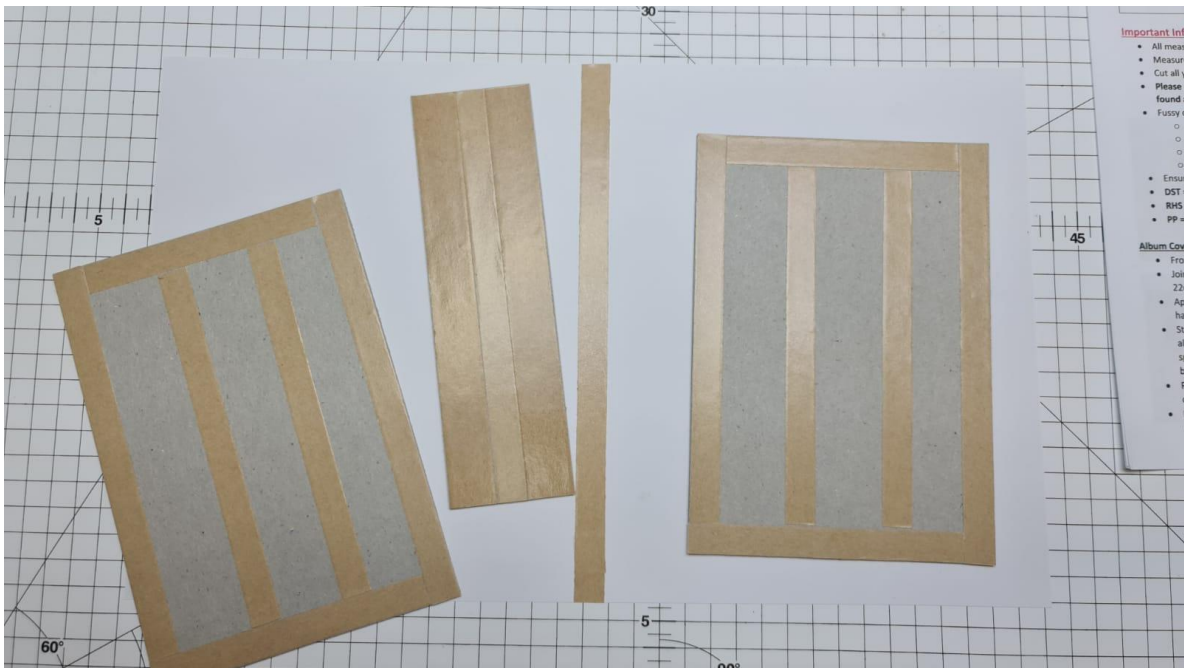
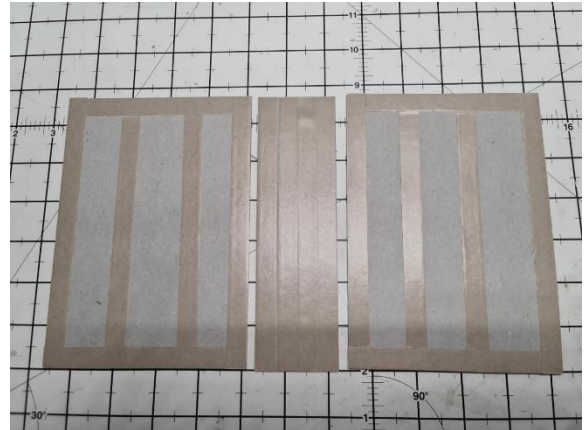
Important Information, please read carefully before you start.

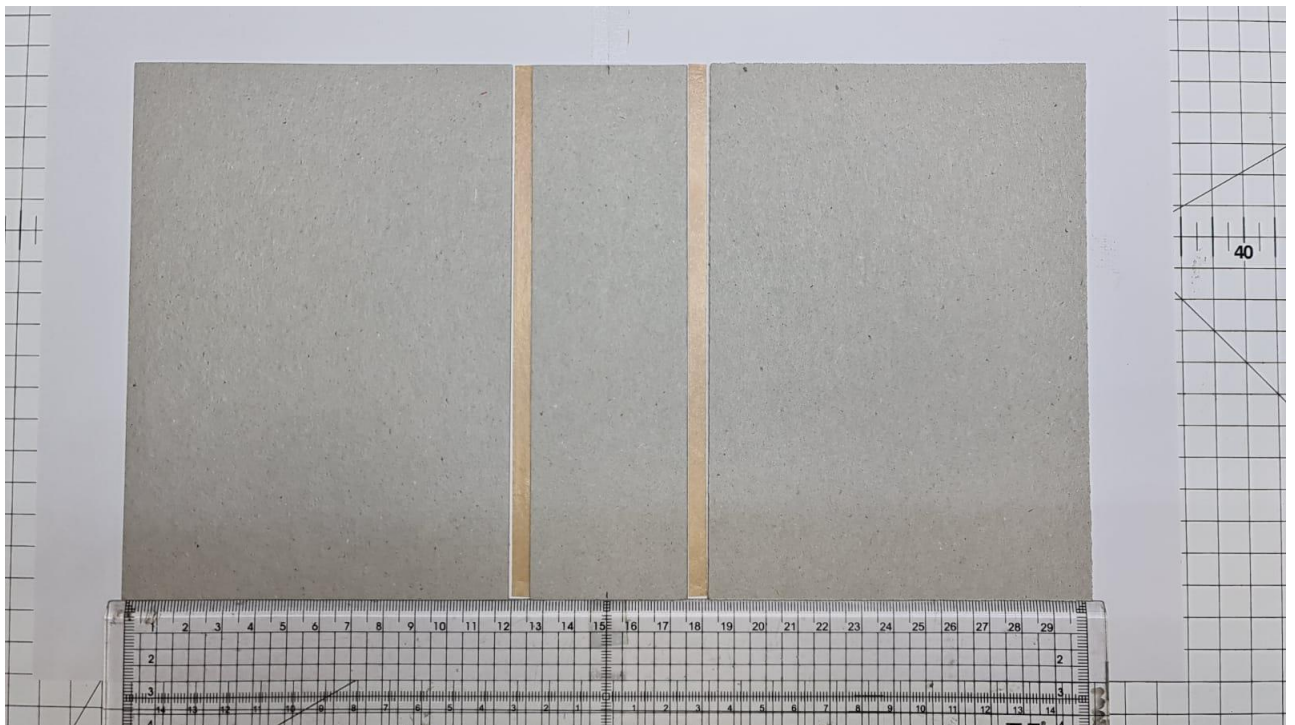
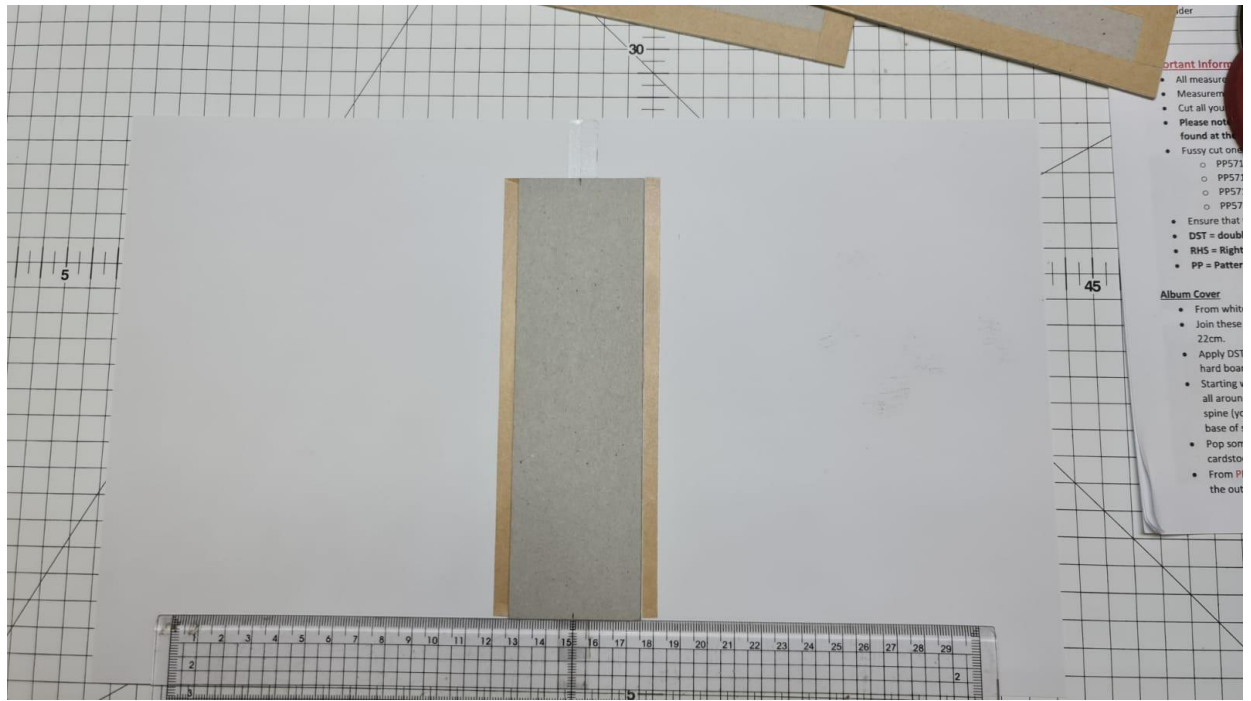
- All measurements are given in **centimetres**.
- Measurements are given **width x height**.
- Cut all your base pages first and keep all the bits for matting and making tags etc.
- **Please note which side of the pattern paper is used! Large format photos of each page can be found at the end of the cutting guide.**
- Fussy cut one of each side of the fussy cutting elements sheets as follows:
- Ensure that you use good quality double-sided tape.
- **DST = double-sided tape** **AS = Advertising strip (barcode)**
- **RHS = Right hand side** **LHS = Left hand side**
- **PP = Patterned Paper**

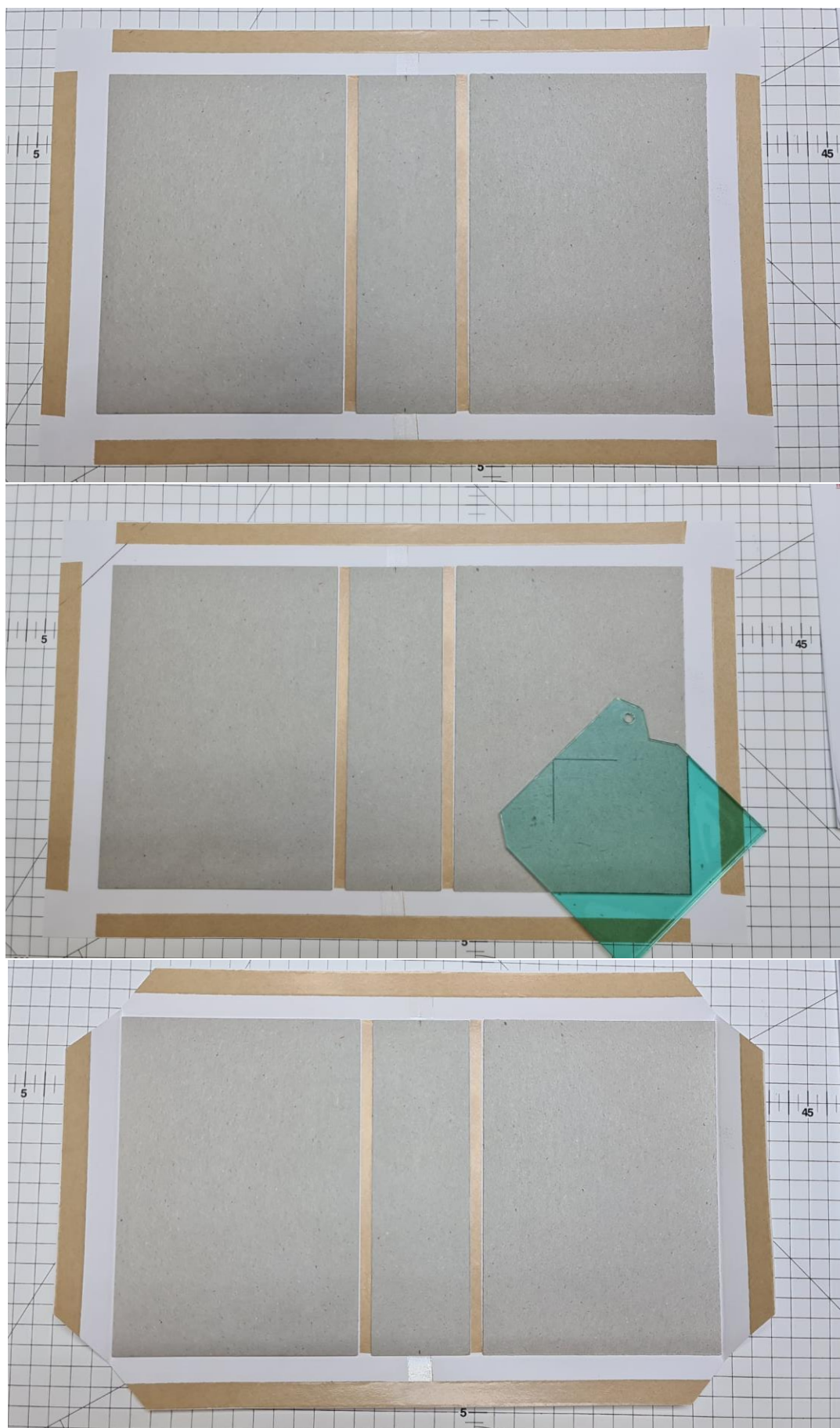
Album Cover (use photos below to assist)

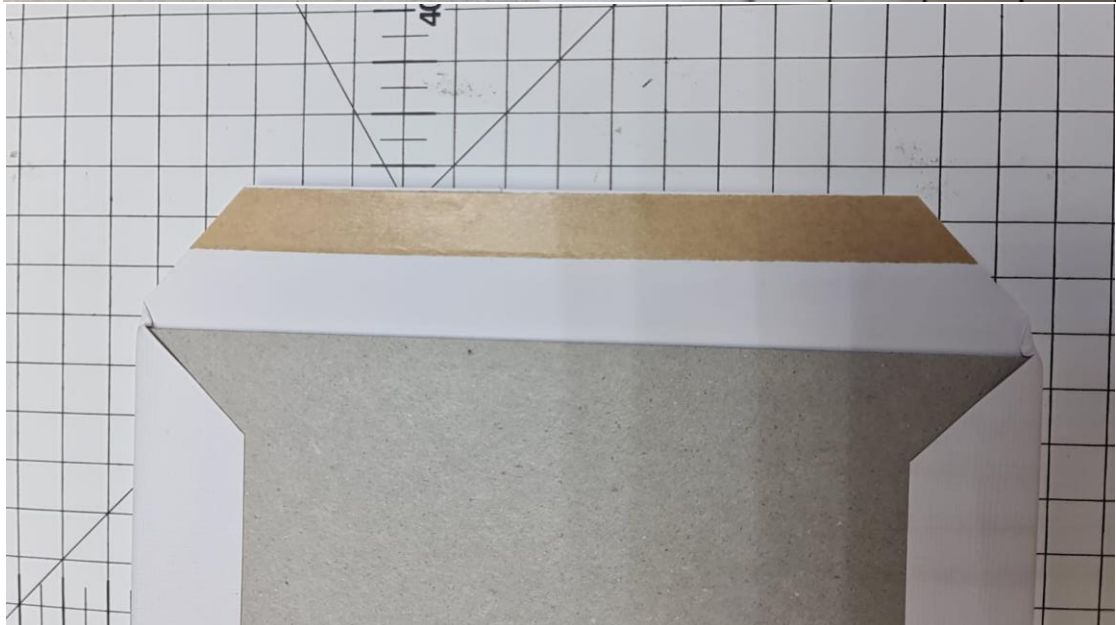
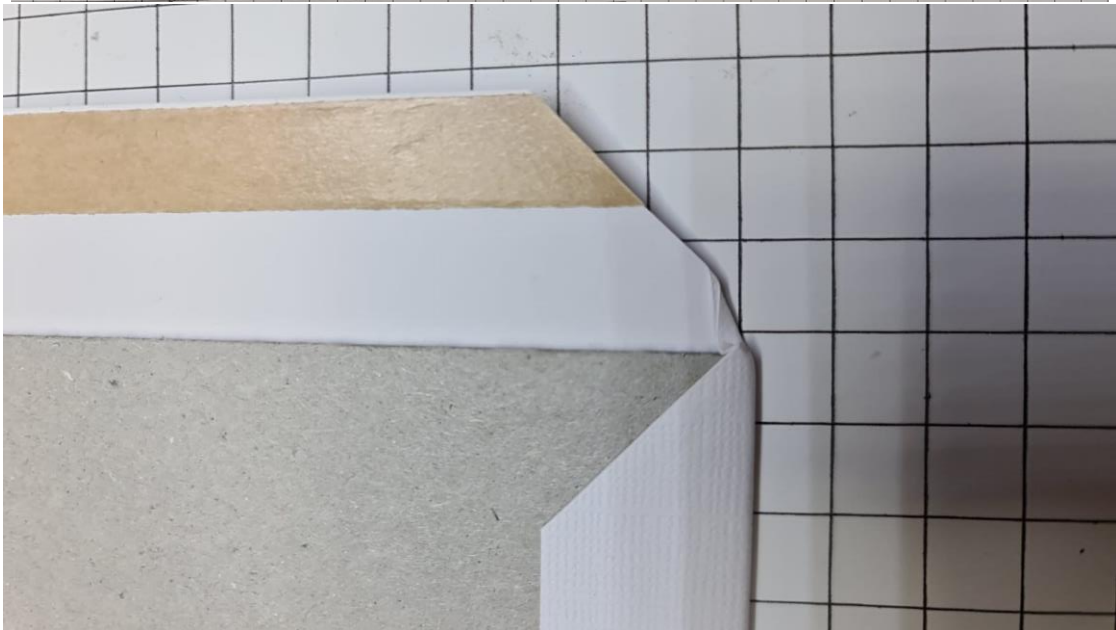
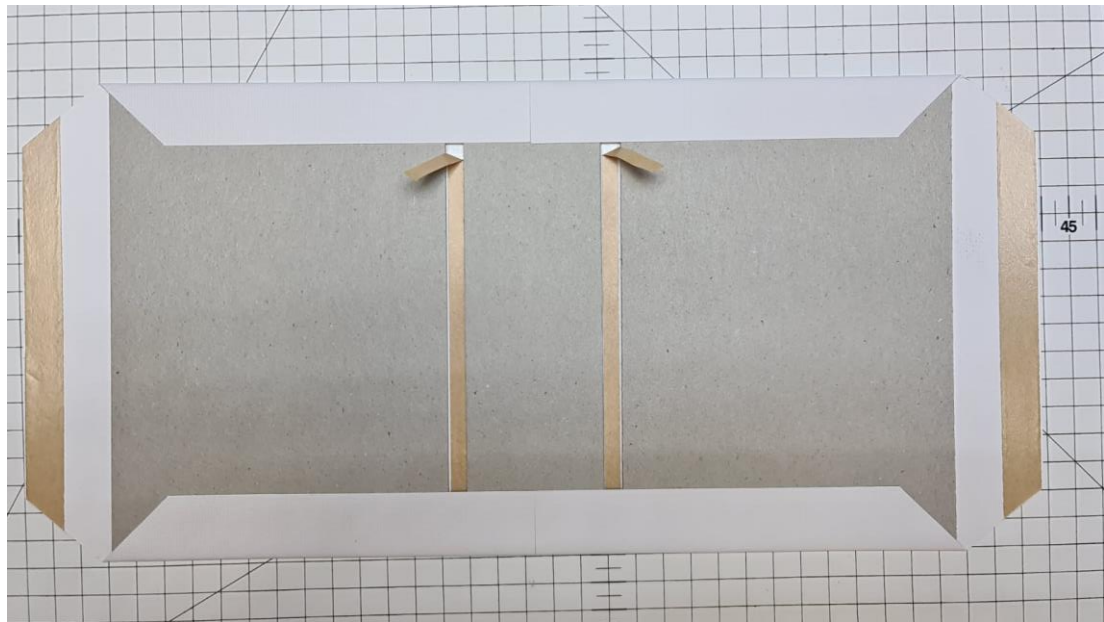
- From pomegranate cardstock, cut 2 identical pieces measuring **18cm x 22cm**.
- Join these 2 pieces of cardstock together to create a single piece of cardstock measuring 36cm x 22cm.
- Adhere DST around the outside edge of the hardboard as well as a few strips in the centre of the hardboard.
- Starting with the spine, place it in the centre (top and bottom and left to right {approx. 2cm border all around}) of this newly created "outer cover", then add a piece of 6mm tape on either side of the spine (you need this gap to stop the spine from tearing) before attaching the covers in line with the base of spine.
- Pop some DST all around the outer edge of the cardstock. Mitre corners, remove DST and fold cardstock in to complete the outer cover.
- From each piece of PP6310, cut a piece that measures 15cm x 16,7cm for the front and back inside cover and stick DST around the outer edges on the wrong/plain side. Make sure that you cut the paper so that you have the images in your cut pieces.
- To stop your inside covers from bulging, you will need to do the following:
 - Add a strip of 12mm tape on each side of the 6mm DST on the hard board (4 pieces in total running from top to bottom of the spine).
 - Add another strip of tape to the spine.
 - Add 2 strips of tape to the inside covers to assist with anchoring the pattern paper.

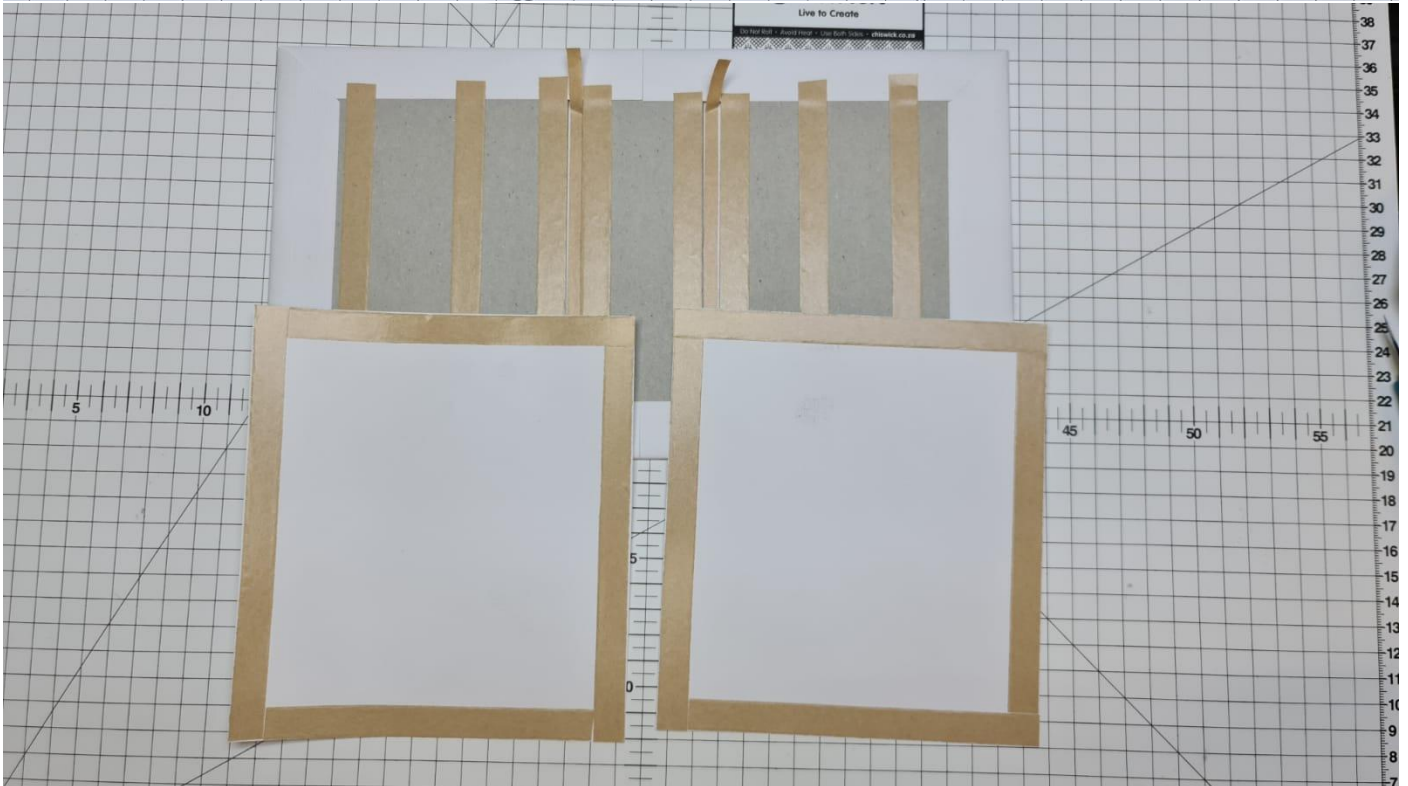
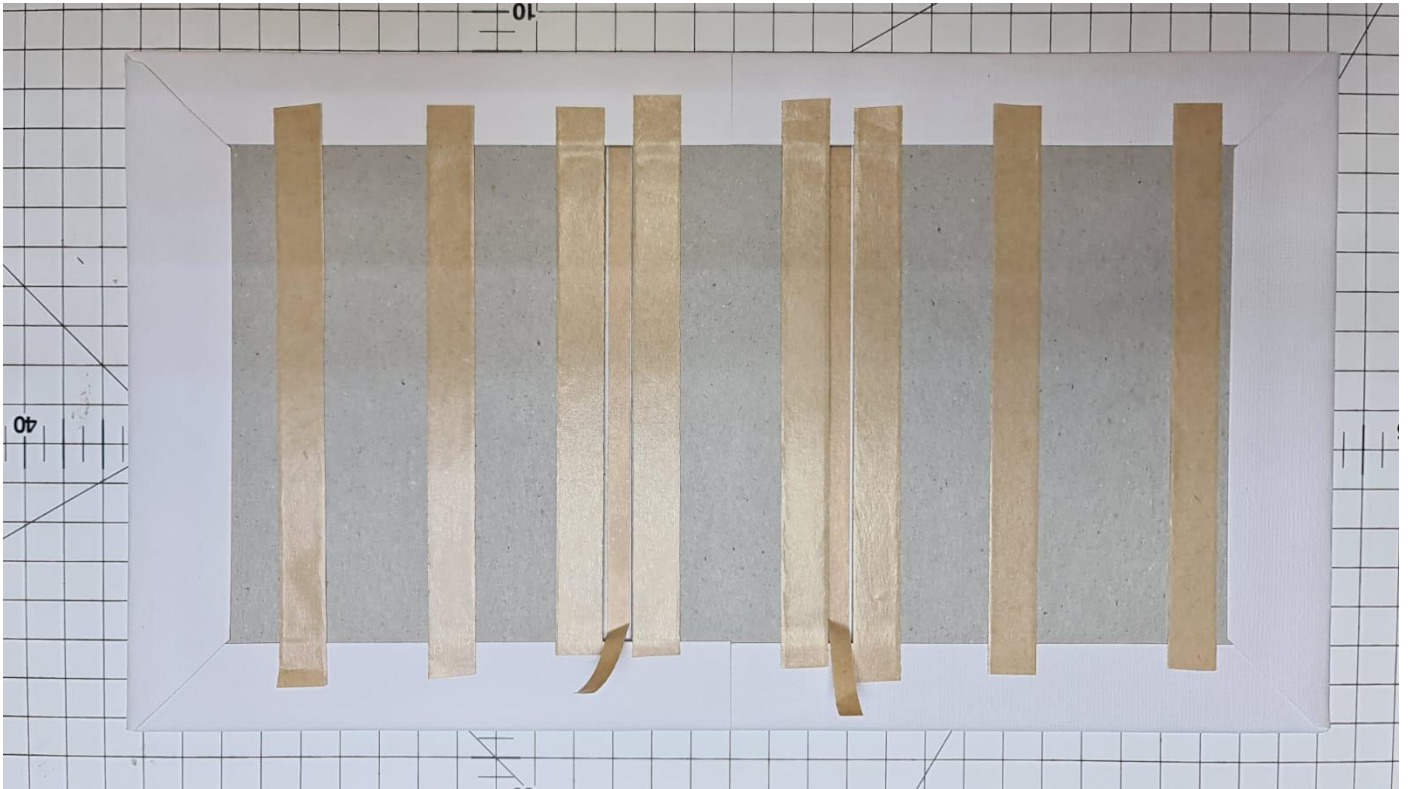
- Carefully remove the DST from the hardboard, including the DST from the 6mm gap between the hardboard and the pattern paper, and attach the inside covers to both front and back.
- Make up the base pages as per the instructions and adhere to the mini album.

Decorating the Front Cover and spine

- From PP6308, cut a piece to 11,5cm x 16cm for the front cover. Mat onto cream and then black cardstock.
- From PP6316, fussy cut the phone booth and cluster with camera etc. Remove the little windows from the phone booth carefully and add a piece of acetate behind the image. Use Foam tape to attach above the phone booth in the image.
- For the spine, colour “A Walk down Memory Lane” using Crimson Copper Brilliance. From your off cuts, cut 1 piece measuring 16cm x 4,5cm (stripe) and another measuring 16,5cm x 5cm (dot). Chalk edges and assemble.
- Attach ribbon to front and back of album.
- Stick image onto front of album and add “Captured in Time” chippie.

Page no.	Pattern paper no.	No. to cut	Measurement	
1	PP6309	1	20cm x 14,7cm	Score at 10cm on the 20cm side. Fold over to create flap. Fussy cut negative from PP6317. Cut to 16cm. Score at 1cm and 15cm on the 16cm side. Remove “inside” of negative from 3 of the “windows” and add a strip of acetate behind the negative. Adhere DST to the right side in the 1cm area created by the score line. Fold in and attach to the front page. Decorate using chippies and fussy cutting elements.
2	PP6315	1 1	10cm x 14,7cm 9cm x 13,7cm	
3	PP6311	1	10cm x 20cm	Score at 14,5cm on the 20cm side.
4	PP6312 PP6318 Black	1 1 1	10cm x 14,7cm 8cm x 11cm	Fussy cut large frame from PP6318. Use elements to create a tuck spot.
5	PP6318 Black	1 1	 7cm x 4,5cm	Fussy cut large and 3 x small frames to use on page. Chalk using Crimson Copper Brilliance.
6	PP6319	1	10cm x 14,7cm	Cut page 6 & 7 together. Do NOT remove advertising strip! Fussy cut both view finder strips from the border page. Stick one on top of the other to create a strip

				approximately 14,5cm x 3cm wide. Attach to the LHS of the page to create a tuck spot.
7	PP6319	1	10cm x 14,7cm	Include the AS in this cut. With the AS on the LHS of the scoreboard, score at 1cm. Apply DST to the wrong side, over the AS. Attach as per photo.
8	PP6308	1	10cm x 14,7cm	Fussy cut a section of the phonebooth and elements to create a tuck spot.
9	PP6309	1	10cm x 14,7cm	Fussy cut a section of the image in the top RH corner to create a tuck spot.
10	PP6313	1	21cm x 14,7cm	Score at 1cm and 11cm on the 21cm side. Apply DST to the 1cm area created by the score line over the writing on the AS. Fold to create a pull-out page.
11	PP6313	1	21cm x 14,7cm	Score at 1cm and 11cm on the 21cm side. Apply DST to the 1cm area created by the score line over the writing on the AS. Fold to create a pull-out page.
12	PP6314	1 1	10cm x 14,7cm 8cm x 12cm	Score at 1cm on the 12cm side. Apply DST to the 1cm area created by the score line on the red wood side.
13	PP6314	1	20cm x 14,7cm	Score at 10cm on the 20cm side. Fold over to create flap.
14	PP6312	1	10cm x 14,7cm	Using your craft knife, cut a few “slits” on your page following the line of the negatives. I have cut 3 slits. Take care when sticking the page down that you don’t seal the slits by mistake.
15	PP6311	1	15cm x 14,7cm	Score at 10cm on the 15cm side.
16	PP6315	1	10cm x 20cm	Score at 14,5cm on the 20cm side.
