You will need:	
Celebr8 A Guy Thing Mini Paper Pack	6mm Double-sided tape (DST)
Celebr8 Mini Album kit	2 x Charcoal Cardstock
1 x Kraft Cardstock	Foam Tape 1mm (small piece for front of album)
Brilliance Starlite Black	Brilliance Starlite Silver
Versa Magic Aspen Mist	Versa Magic Night Sky
1 x Magnet	Scoreboard (cm)
Paper Trimmer / Craft Knife	Small, sharp scissors for fussy cutting
Bone folder	2 x Brads

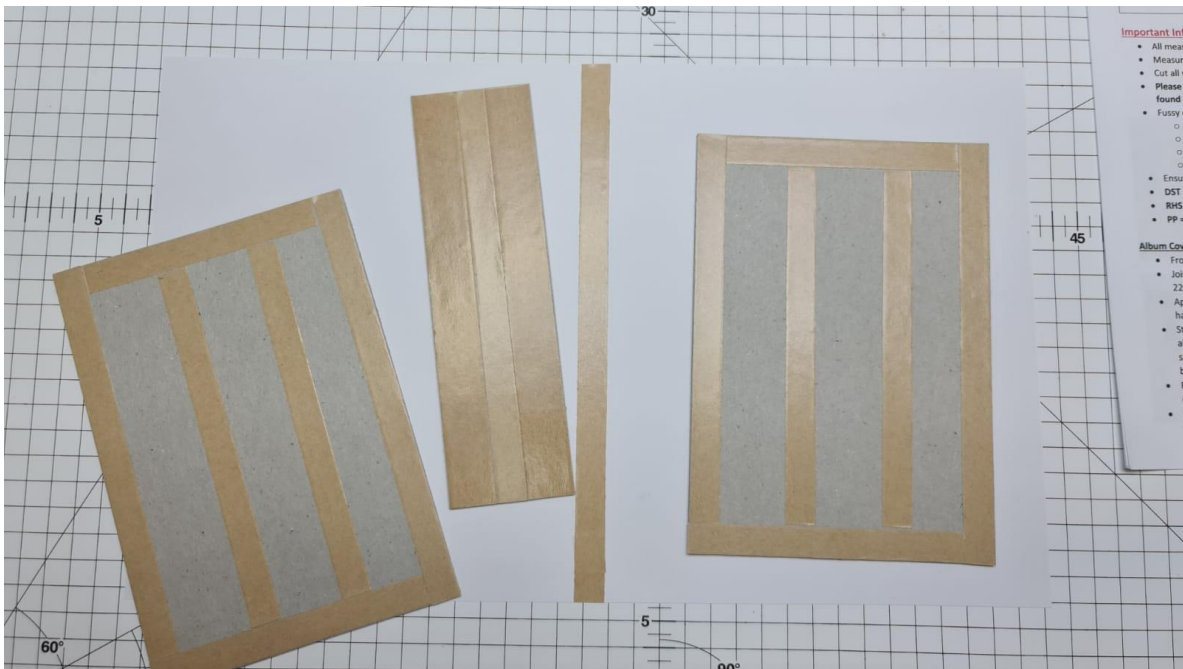
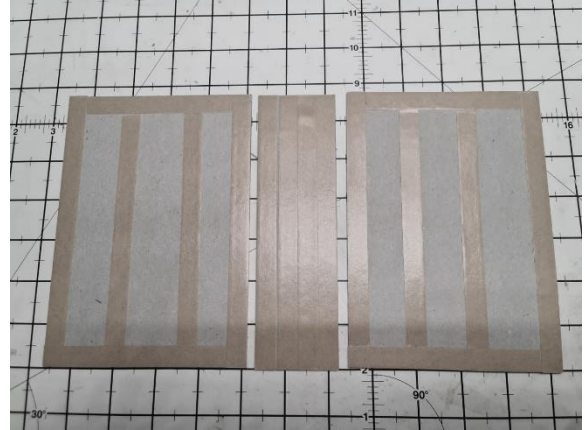
Important Information, please read carefully before you start.

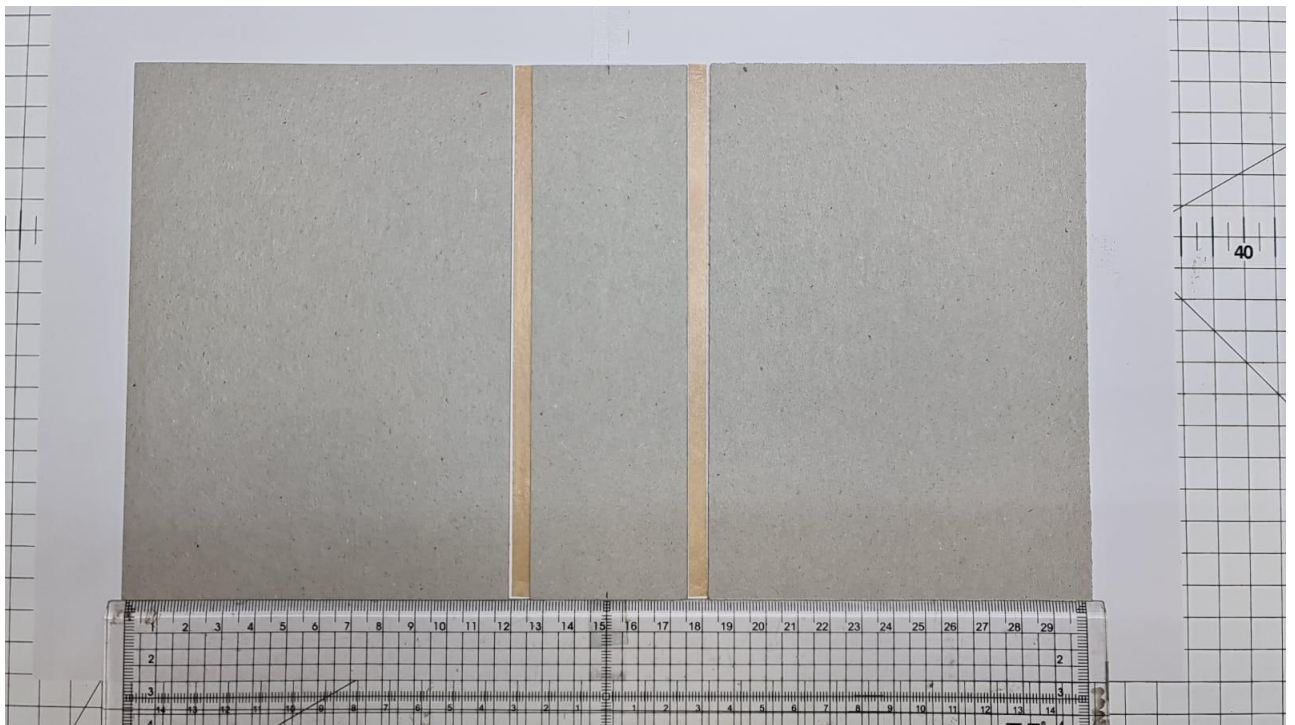
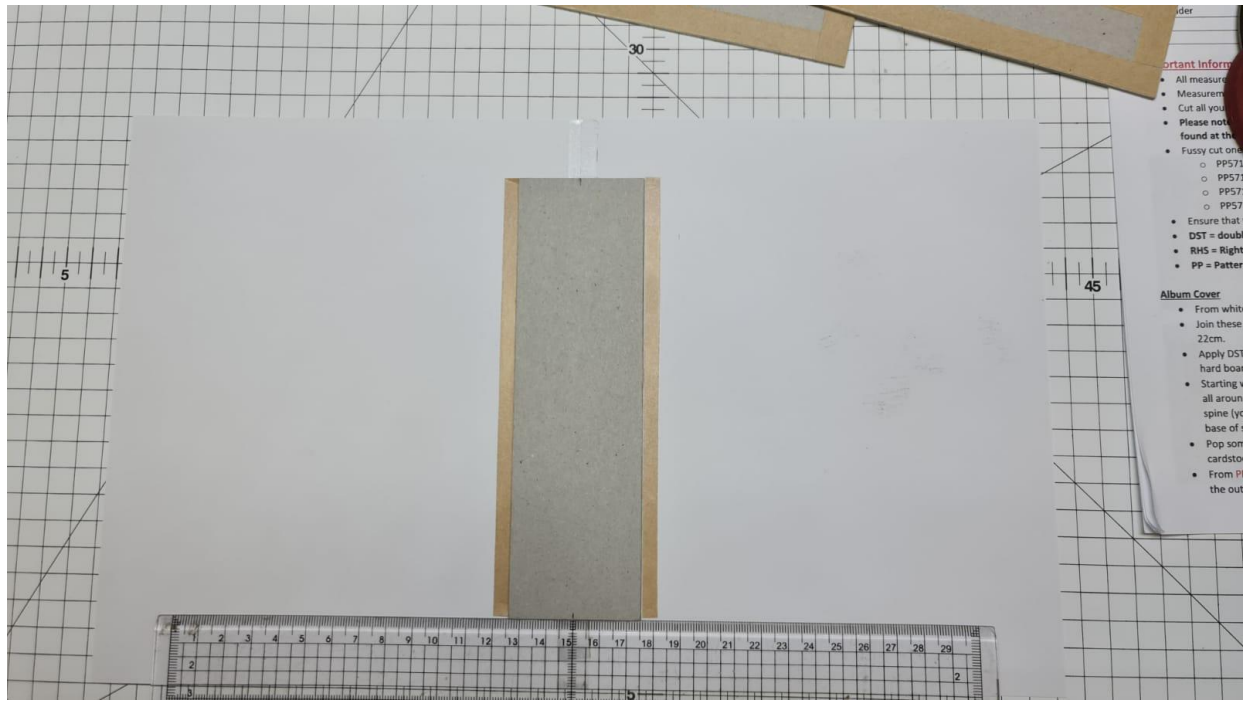
- All measurements are given in **centimetres**.
- Measurements are given **width x height**.
- Cut all your base pages first and keep all the bits for matting and making tags etc.
- **Please note which side of the pattern paper is used!**
- Fussy cut one of each side of the fussy cutting elements sheets as follows:
 - PP6216 – Fussy cutting sheet
 - PP6217 – Journaling cards
 - PP6218 – Words
 - PP6219 – Circles and Tags
- Ensure that you use good quality double-sided tape.
- **DST = Double-sided tape** **AS = Advertising Strip (barcode)**
- **RHS = Right Hand Side** **LHS = Left Hand Side**
- **PP = Patterned Paper** **CS = Cardstock**

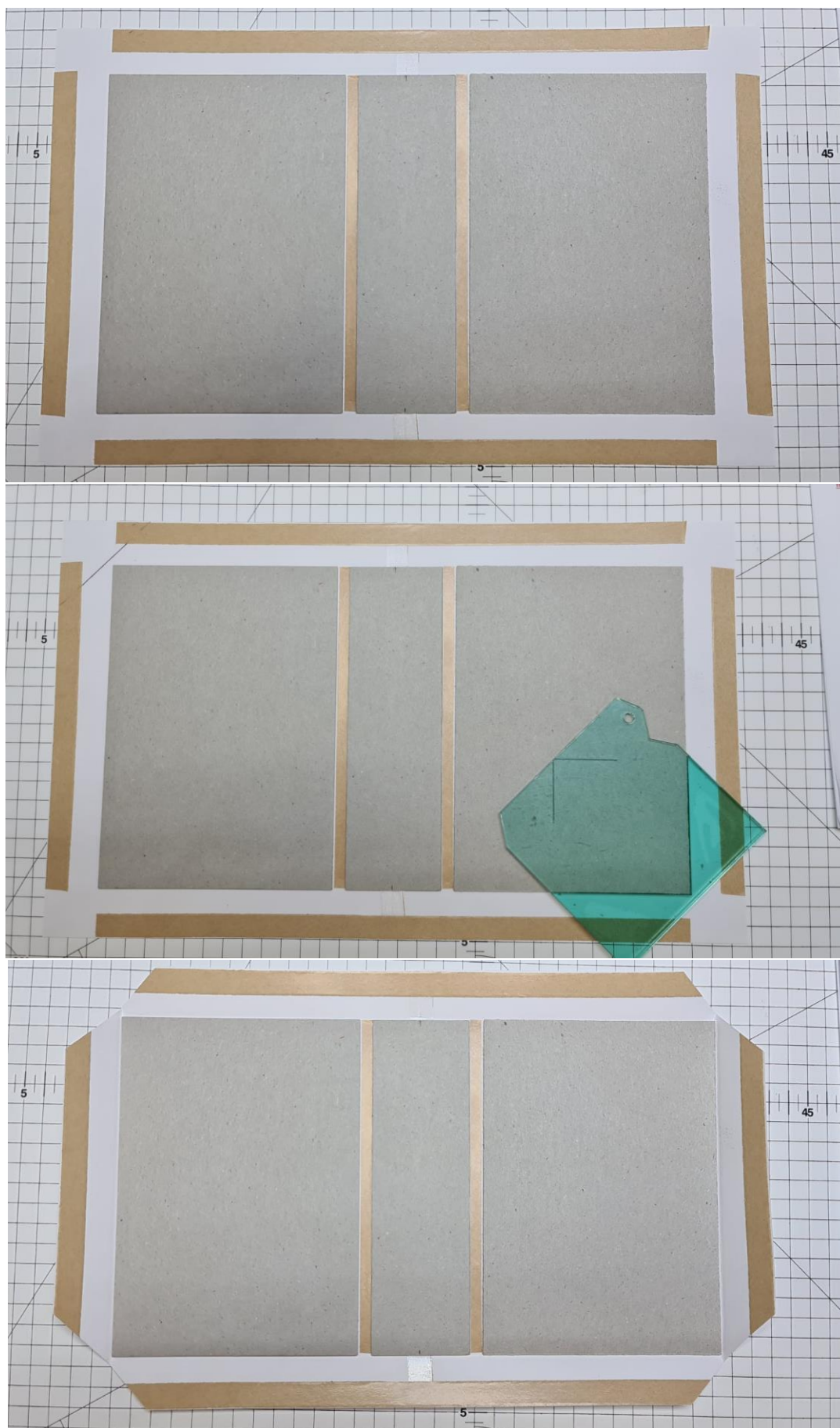
Album Cover (use photos below to assist)

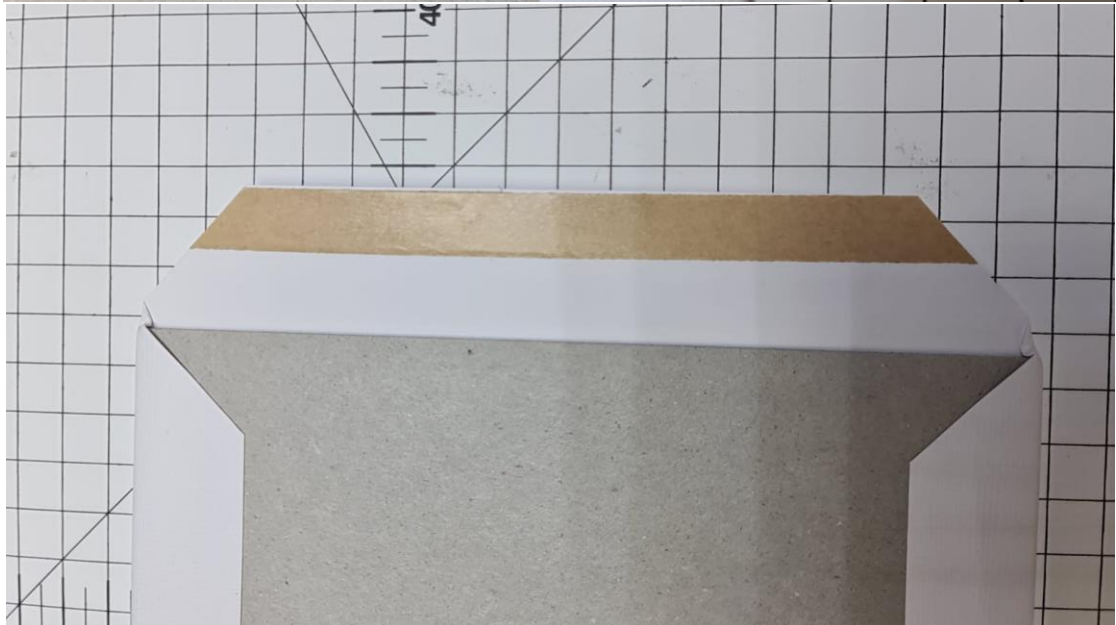
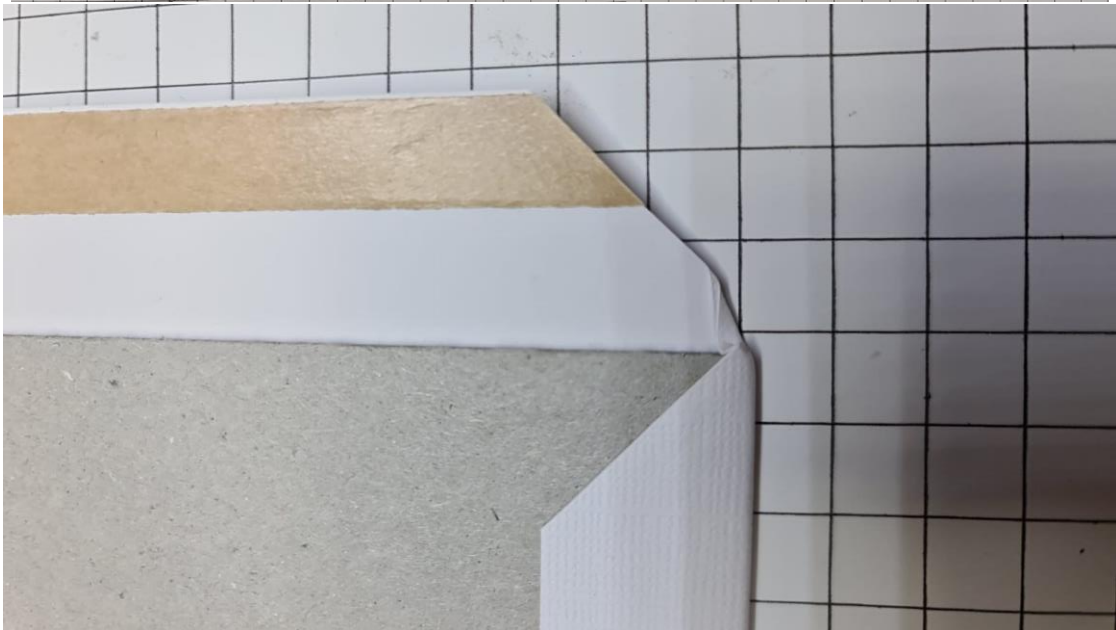
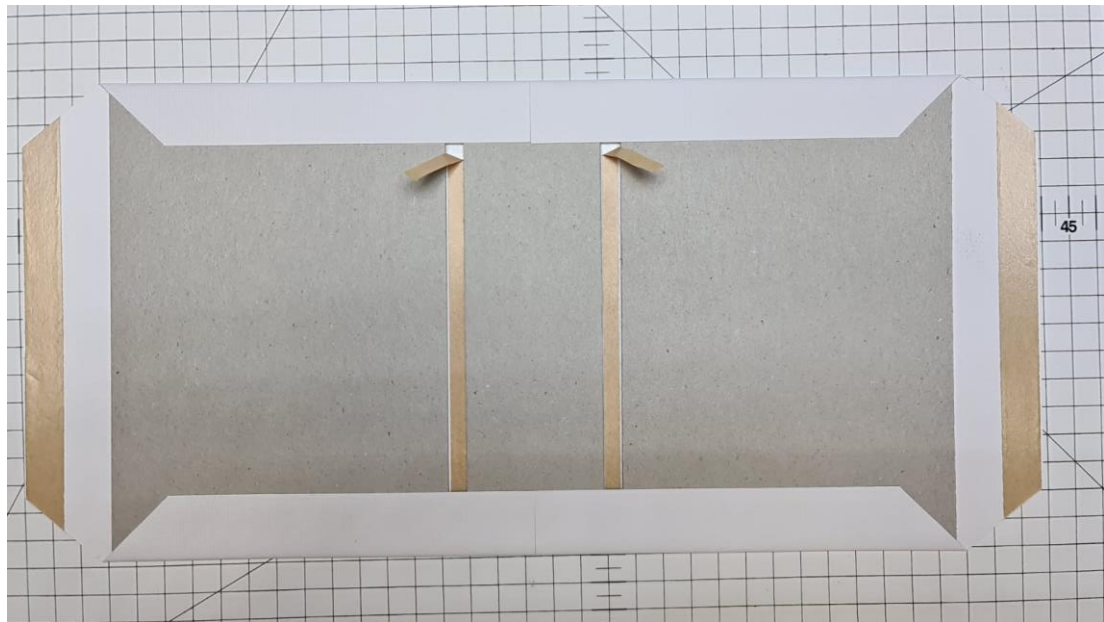
- From charcoal cardstock, cut 2 identical pieces measuring **18cm x 22cm**.
- Join these 2 pieces of cardstock together to create a single piece of cardstock measuring 36cm x 22cm.
- Adhere DST around the outside edge of the hardboard as well as a few strips in the centre of the hardboard.
- Starting with the spine, place it in the centre (top and bottom and left to right {approx. 2cm border all around}) of this newly created “outer cover”, then add a piece of 6mm tape on either side of the spine (you need this gap to stop the spine from tearing) before attaching the covers in line with the base of spine.
- Pop some DST all around the outer edge of the cardstock. Mitre corners, remove DST and fold cardstock in to complete the outer cover.
- Use both pieces of PP6212 to cut two pieces that measures 15cm x 16,7cm for the front and back inside covers. Stick DST around the outer edges on the wrong/plain side. Make sure that you cut the paper so that you have the little image in your cut piece.

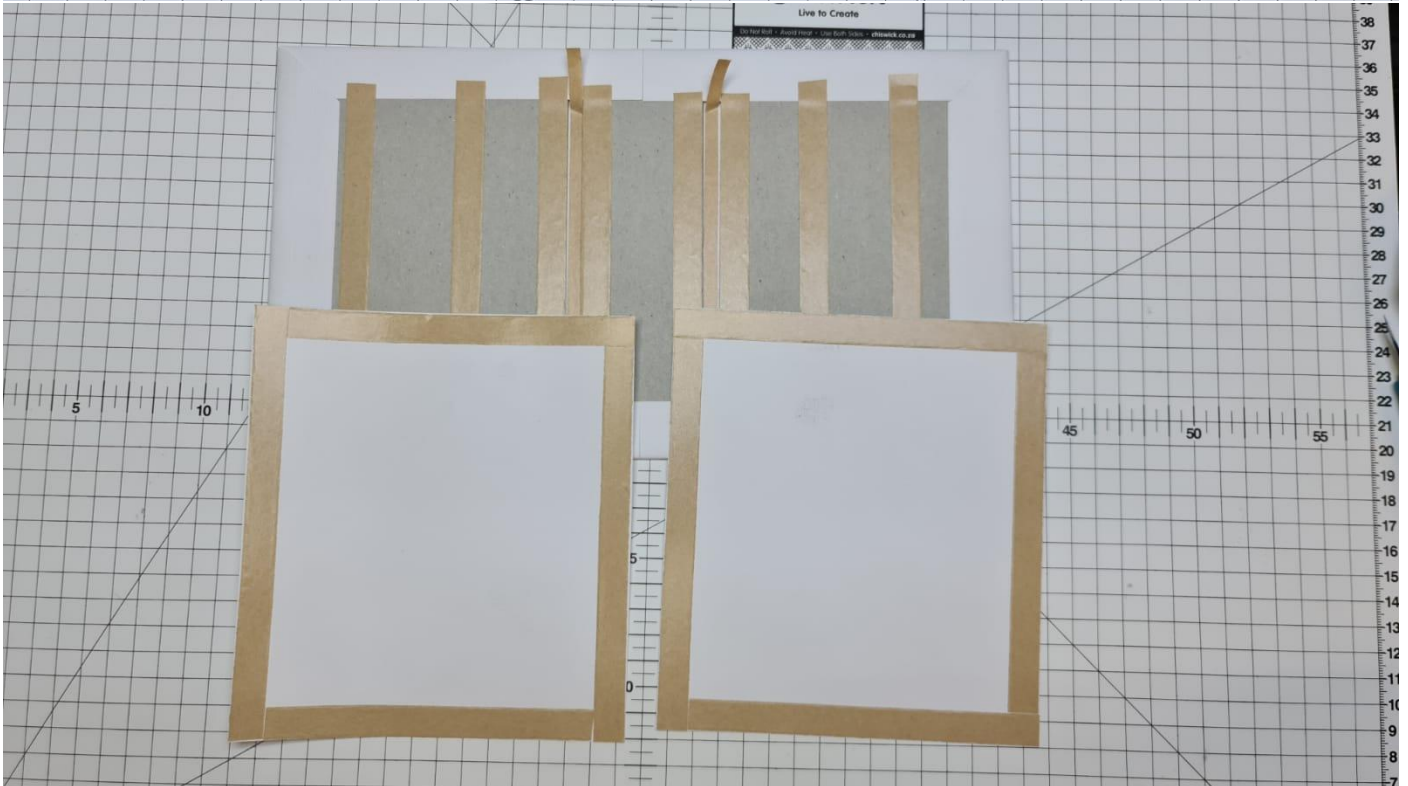
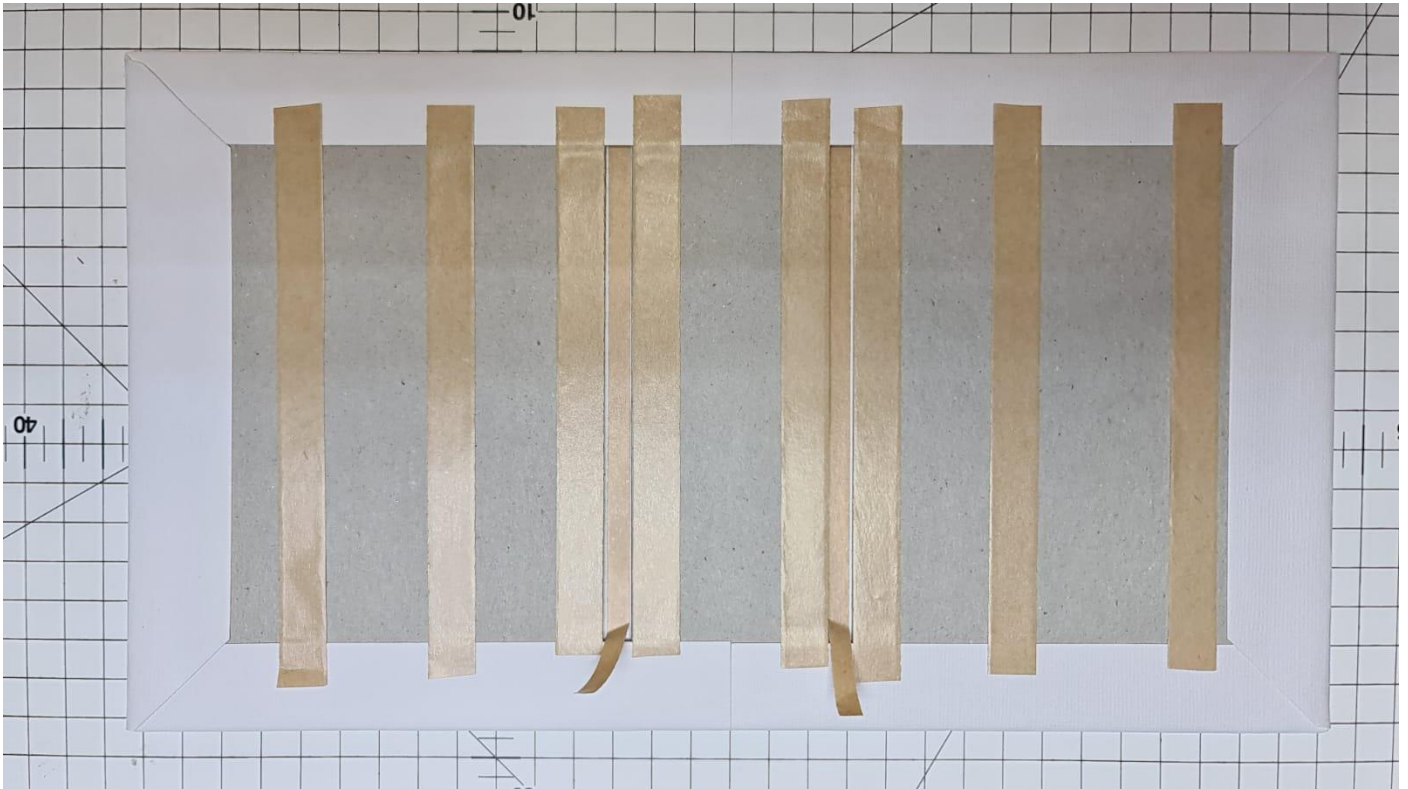
- To stop your inside covers from bulging, you will need to do the following:
 - Add a strip of 12mm tape on each side of the 6mm DST on the hard board (4 pieces in total running from top to bottom of the spine).
 - Add another strip of tape to the spine.
 - Add 2 strips of tape to the inside covers to assist with anchoring the pattern paper.
- Carefully remove the DST from the hardboard, including the DST from the 6mm gap between the hardboard and the pattern paper, and attach the inside covers to both front and back.
- Make up the base pages as per the instructions – this will form the little mini album inside the box.

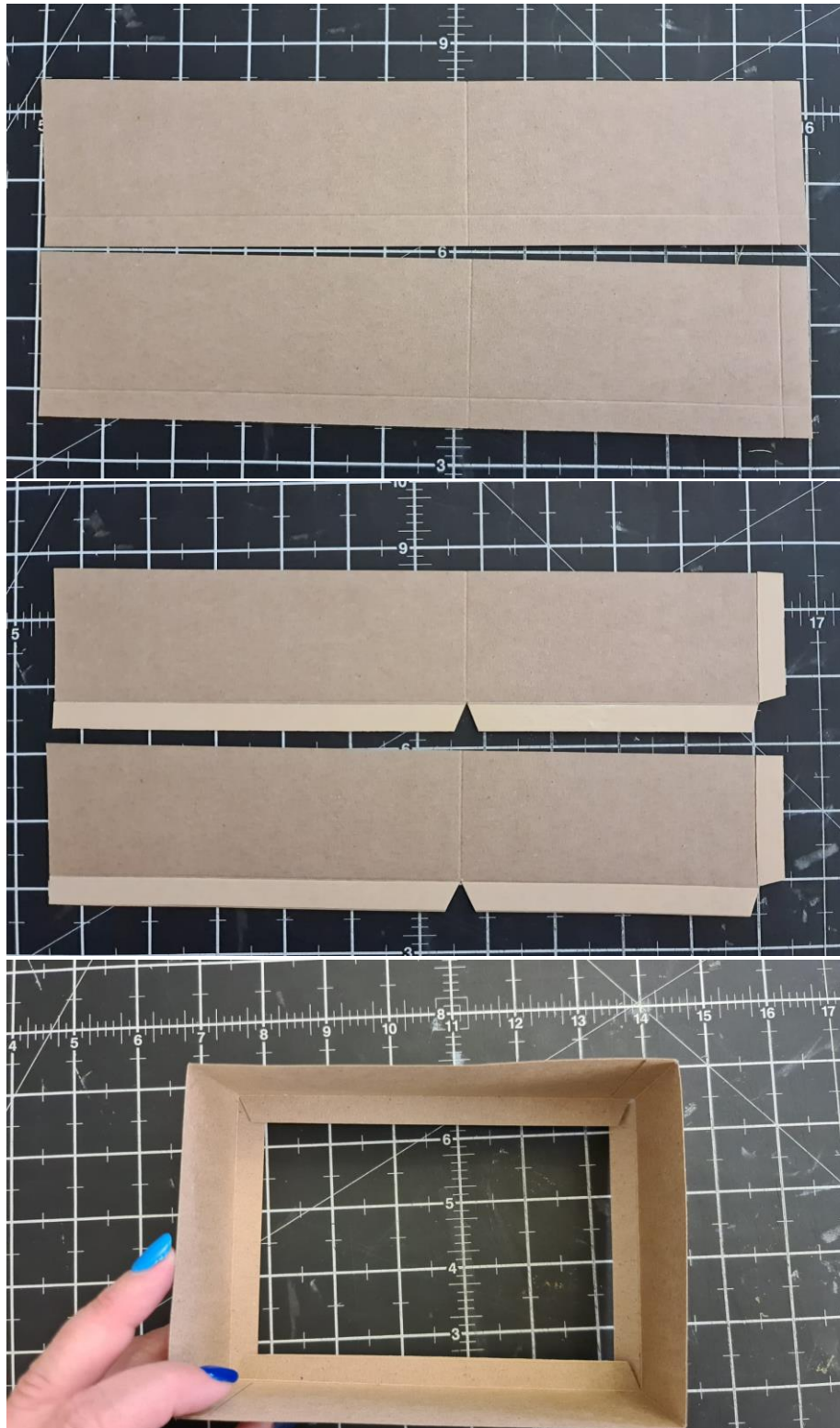






Creating the "box"

- Cut 2 strips of kraft measuring 27,5cm x 6cm.
- Score at 1cm and 11,5cm on the 27,5cm side. Turn 90° and score at 5cm on the 6cm side.
- Adhere DST in the 1cm area created by the score line. Mitre as per photos.
- Join 2 pieces together to create the "box".

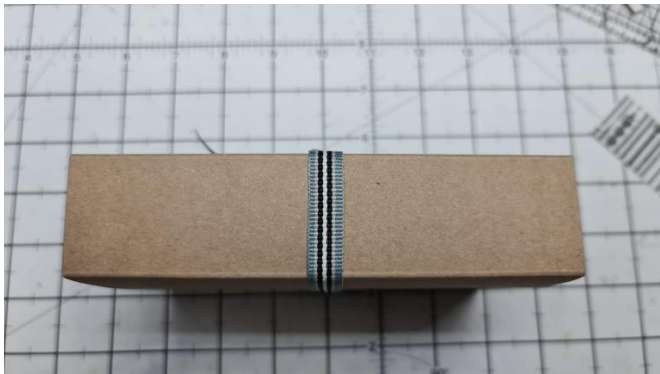


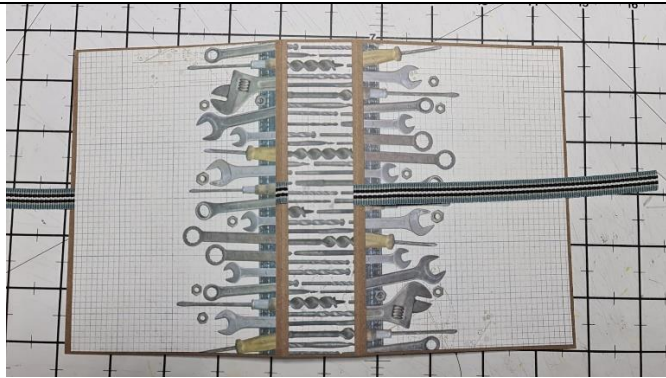
Decorating the Front of Box

- From PP6210, cut a piece measuring 12cm x 16,5cm (make sure you get the image in your cut section). Add the handle (instructions given below) before sticking onto front of box.
- From PP6215, cut the third strip from the RHS to create the handle.
 - Cut this strip down to 13cm and mat onto left over kraft to add strength.
 - Stick onto box using glue or DST. I used 2 brads that I had in my stash to secure the handle.
- From the fussy cut sheet, cut the spanner and cogs.
 - Mat onto kraft to add strength.
 - Stick the spanner onto the side of the box so that the cogs hang over the edge.
 - Add a magnet to the underside of the element.
- Add fussy cut elements, a dome sticker and some chippies to create interest.



Fussy cut element for closure.

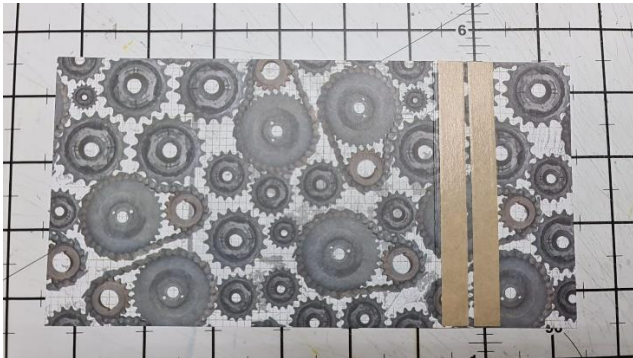
Page no.	Pattern paper no.	No. to cut	Measurement	
Prior to sticking down the mats for the base pages, add the ribbon to the album as follows:  Position ribbon supplied in the kit on the centre of the spine. Anchor in place with some DST.				

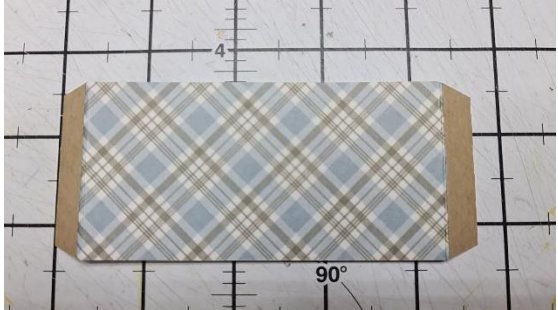


Stick down pieces for page 1 and 16 which have now become your front and back cover. Measurements are given in the table.

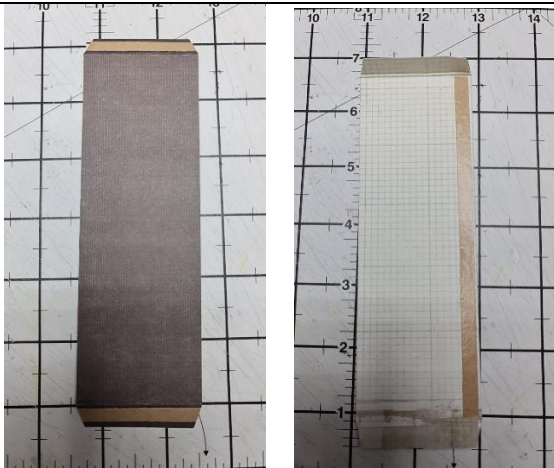
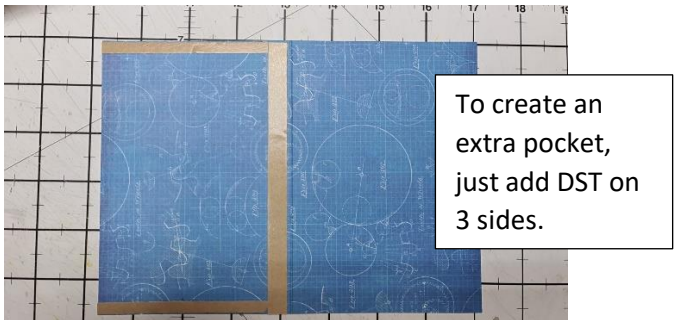
Use a piece of left-over paper from the inner cover of the box cut to 3cm x 14,5cm to cover the spine.

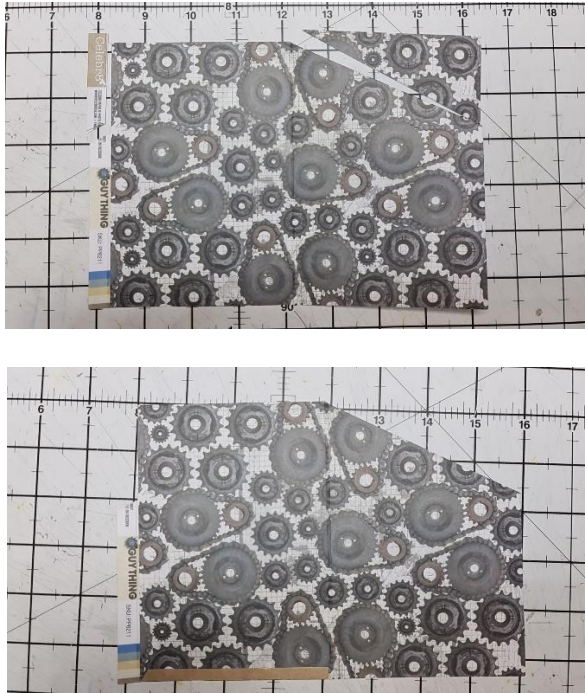
1 Front cover	PP6210 PP6216	2	10cm x 14,5cm	Use second piece for page 16. Use fussy cutting elements, chipboard title and dome sticker to decorate the front cover. I used a combination of Aspen Mist, Night Sky and Starlite Silver to decorate the chippie.
2	White CS PP6214	1 1	10,5cm x 9cm 10cm x 14,5cm	Score at 1cm on the 9cm side. Apply DST to the 1cm area created by the score line.  Choose 1 of the journaling cards from PP6217 to add to the flap. LEAVE THE AS ON! Adhere PP6214 on top of "hinge" to hide attachment. (Retain excess for page 10.) 

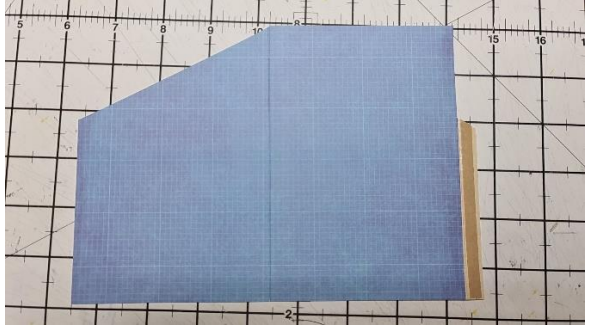
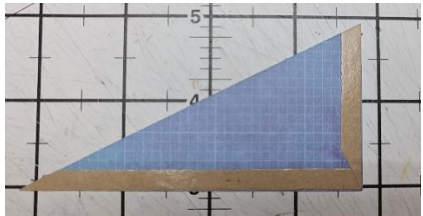
				
3	PP6211	1	10cm x 20cm	Score at 5,5cm on the 20cm side. Adhere DST to the small “cog” side and stick into album so that a tuck spot is also created.  
4	PP6213	1	19cm x 14,5cm	Leave AS on and include in your measuring. With the AS up against the LHS of the scoreboard, score at 10cm on the 19cm side. This will allow you to see the AS strip when the page is in the closed position. 

5	PP6210 PP6209	1	10cm x 14,5cm 12cm x 5cm	Adhere to album. Cut page 9 first - use off cut to create the belly band. Score at 1cm and 11cm on the 12cm side. Apply DST to the right side in the 1cm area created by the score line. Mitre corners! 
6	PP6217 PP6217	1 1	10cm x 14,5cm 10cm x 7,5cm	Ensure that you work on the side with the rectangles so that you cut it correctly. Score at 1cm on the 10cm side to create a flap.  Add fussy cut elements to decorate.
7	PP6219	1	12cm x 14cm	Score at 1cm and 11cm on the 12cm side. Turn 90° and score at 13cm on the 14cm side. Adhere DST to the right side in the 1cm area created by the score line. Mitre corners. Fold in to form a pocket. 

	White CS	1	9cm x 13cm	Create a tag for your pocket using the white cardstock in your pack.
8	PP6208	1	10cm x 20cm	With the image up against the LHS of the scoreboard, score at 14,5cm on the 20cm side. Use the off cut from page 8 on page 11. 
9	PP6209	1	10cm x 20cm	With the image up against the LHS of the scoreboard, score at 14,5cm on the 20cm side.
10	PP6214	1	10cm x 14,5cm	Use off cut from page 2. Include the AS in your cutting. With the AS on the LHS, score at 1cm on the 10cm side. Apply DST over the writing of the AS to create a flap. Cut this piece with page 11.
	PP6214	1	9cm x 14,5cm	
11	PP6214	1	10cm x 14,5cm	Use off cut from page 8. Score at 1cm and 15,5cm on the 16,5cm side. Adhere DST to the right side in the 1cm area created by the score line. Mitre corners! Add a strip of DST along the long side to seal pocket.

12	PP6209 PP6213	1 1	15cm x 14,5cm 7,5cm x 14,5cm	Score at 5cm and 12,5cm on the 15cm side. Adhere just the 2,5cm area created by the score line to mini album to allow the page to flap. Adhere under flap.  
13	PP6218	1	20cm x 14,5cm	Score at 10cm on the 20cm side to create a flap. 

	White CS	1	10cm x 11cm	Score at 1cm and 10cm on the 11cm side. Turn 90° and score at 10cm on the 11cm side. Adhere DST to the right side in the 1cm area created by the score line. Mitre corners. Fold in to form a pocket. 
14	PP6211	1	21cm x 14,5cm	Retain AS. Use the photos below to assist. With the AS on your LHS and the “gears” facing upwards, score at 1cm and 11cm on the 21cm side. Measure down 5cm on the RHS and cut a diagonal from the centre score line to the 5cm mark. Retain the triangle for page 15. Remove a portion of the 1cm hinge (photo 2). Adhere DST to the right side in the 1cm area created by the score line as well as along the base of the pocket (photo 2). Mitre corners. Fold in to form a pocket.
